If your household is using more than 1,000 gallons per person per month (2,000 for a teen), you may want to check for leaks or consider other water saving steps.

Indoor Water Saving Tips:

- Fix Leaks: Regularly check faucets, pipes, and toilets for leaks and repair them promptly.
- Water-Efficient Fixtures: Install water-saving showerheads, faucet aerators, and low-flush toilets.
- Shorten Showers: Reduce shower time to conserve water.
- Turn off the Tap: Turn off the tap while brushing teeth, shaving, or washing hands.
- © Reuse Water: Collect water from rinsing vegetables, washing dishes, or showers to reuse for watering plants.
- Limit Dishwasher and Washing Machine Usage: Only run full loads and use efficient cycles.

Outdoor Water Saving Tips:

- Water Plants Efficiently: Water plants in the early morning or evening to minimize evaporation.
- Use Water Wisely: Avoid hosing down driveways or sidewalks; use a broom instead.
- Consider Rainwater Harvesting: Consider a water barrel or other rainwater harvesting methods.

Water Billing Information

Village of Alexandria water bills are mailed/emailed and due each month. **Bills are due on receipt and payment must be received by the 25**th of each month. If you do not receive a bill by the 15th of the month, please contact us at 740-924-2539 prior to the due date. A ten percent (10%) penalty is applied after the due date on current charges. Failure to pay by the due date will result in a courtesy delinquent notice to be sent and water service may be discontinued. All unpaid accounts will become a lien against the property served.

Water bills may be paid online (www.alexandriaoh.gov), by mail (PO Box 96, Alexandria, OH 43001), or in person at the Village Office at 4 West Main Street. An outside drop box is available during hours that the Village Office is closed. Both the PO Box and drop box are checked for receipts on the 25th.

Property owners are responsible for maintaining their piping and plumbing fixtures in good condition and no adjustments will be made for leaks that register on water meters. Where the water account is held in a tenant's name, the property owner will receive a courtesy copy of the monthly water bill.
