

A RESOLUTION GIVING FINAL APPROVAL TO THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF VIRGIL CLAYTON AS A PART-TIME POLICE OFFICER FOR THE VILLAGE OF ALEXANDRIA, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 737.16 Ohio Revised Code, the Mayor appointed Virgil Clayton as a part-time Police Officer for the Village of Alexandria to begin on April 2, 2024; and

WHEREAS, THE Council for the Village of Alexandria confirmed this appointment by adopting Resolution 2024-06 on May 7, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Officer Clayton has satisfactorily served a probationary period of six months consecutive service,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ALEXANDRIA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Section 737.16, Ohio Revised Code, Council for the Village of Alexandria hereby gives final approval to the Mayor's appointment of Virgil Clayton as a part-time Police Officer, effective April 1, 2025.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.


SECTION 4. All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are consistent with this Resolution is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.

SECTION 5. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and specifically so that the above named Officer may immediately continue serving to his full capacity. Wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in the force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
