

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF SCOTT MCKNIGHT AS AN AUXILIARY POLICE OFFICER FOR THE VILLAGE OF ALEXANDRIA, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 737.161 Ohio Revised Code, the Mayor may appoint auxiliary police officers to serve within the police department of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has appointed Scott McKnight to serve as an auxiliary police officer of the Village of Alexandria,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ALEXANDRIA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Council for the Village of Alexandria hereby approves the Mayor's appointment of Scott McKnight as an auxiliary police officer, effective upon the passage of this resolution.


SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and specifically so that the above named Officer may immediately continue serving to his full capacity. Wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in the force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


