**UNITED STAFF FOR GAZA LAUNCHES DUTY STATION NETWORKS**

United Staff for Gaza announces a **significant step forward** as it grows, consolidates, and expands its advocacy for human rights and respect for international law.

United Staff for Gaza launches **Duty Station Networks**, through which its supporters will be provided with opportunities to organize within their respective duty stations around the world. The Networks will operate alongside United Staff for Gaza's Core Group and Strategic Coordination Team, to support projects and workstreams and conduct activities of their own.

Duty Station Networks will operate under the facilitation of Convenors.

In a first phase, United Staff for Gaza will focus on shaping Networks in Amman, Geneva, New York, and Rome. Networks may nevertheless be established in any duty station, subject to the volume of interest.

“United Staff for Gaza provides a safe space in which colleagues can gather to learn about and speak up for Palestine, international law, and the UN’s values,” said [Lourdes Orlando](#), who works at the UN Food and Agriculture Organization in Rome. **“The Duty Station Networks will enable colleagues to connect and gather in person for vigils, public mobilizations, film screenings, and other ways to contribute meaningfully to Palestine solidarity.”**
