As to make it a piece of cake, there are simplified five phases in phonics with **DICE+ Phonics**.

“Today a reader, tomorrow a leader.”

PHASE 1

Phase 1 develops a child's ability to listen and talk about sounds like environmental sounds, instrumental sounds, Rhythm and Rhyme alliteration voice sounds and oral blending, etc.,
The students basically learn to read the alphabets with the proper sound structure.

The main focus in second phase is with short vowels.

It is the very root for the proper reading. Short vowels are vowel sounds that are pronounced in a short form. In English the short vowel sounds are those in 'pet', 'pot', 'put', 'putt', 'pat' and 'pit', and the schwa sound.

PHASE 3

Long Vowels

The phase 3 sticks with Long Vowels. The resources include all the letters grapheme along with word cards.

Phase 3 builds on Phase 2 where children learn more sounds easy and tricky. The five vowels of the English spelling system ('a', 'e', 'i', 'o' and 'u') have a corresponding long vowel sound /eɪ/, /i:/, /aɪ/, /oʊ/, /yu/.

“To learn to read is to light a fire”.

In phase 4, Children consolidate their phoneme knowledge from phase 3 and begin to blend and spell. In this phase sounds with adjacent consonants or initial and final blends are taught.

Ex: bl, dr, sc, ft, ct (soft, act, draw).

PHASE 5

In this phase double letter vowels are expressively learnt. In further segmentation is given more importance and diphthongs along with its blending included in this level. All the books have been meticulously structured to help students to practice and apply their decoding skill.
