CROCHET ABBREVIATIONS

ch - chain

sl st - slip stitch

sc - single crochet

hdc - half double crochet

dc - double crochet

tr - treble crochet

inc - increase

dec - decrease

blo - back loop only

flo - front loop only

st(s) - stitch(es)

[] - total stitch count

* - number of times to repeat the stitch

MATERIALS NEEDED

2.00mm hook

Scissors

5ply Milk Cotton Yarn (Beige, Black/Dark Brown, Red)

3ply Milk Cotton Yarn (Black)

2ply Milk Cotton Yarn (Black)

Darning Needle

Cotton Stuffing

Keychain Hook

REMEMBER: slst and ch1 at the end of every stitch to start a new row unless stated otherwise.

HEAD

- 1: mr, 6sc [6]
- 2: (inc)*6 [12]
- 3: (1sc, 1inc)*6 [18]
- 4: (2sc, inc)*6 [24]
- 5-10: sc in every st [24]
- 11: (2sc, dec)*6 [18]
- ➔ Start Stuffing
- 12: (1sc, dec)*6 [12]
- 13: (dec)*6 [6]

➔ Cut the yarn and sew the end around the decrease stitches before tightening it

FACE

- 1: mr, 6sc
- 2: (inc)*6 [12]
- 3: (1sc, inc)*6 [18]
- 4: (2sc, inc)*6 [24]

➔ Cut your yarn leaving a long piece for sewing

MUZZLE

➔ starting with red yarn

- 1: ch10, starting from the 2nd ch from the hook, do a sc until the last chain [9]
- 2: add 4 sc into the last ch, rotate your work, do 9 sc, slst to the first sc [22]

 ➔ change color to the same as the face

- 3-4: sc all around [22]

➔ Cut your yarn leaving a long piece for sewing

OUTER EAR

➔ using black/dark brown yarn

- 1: mr, 6sc
 - 2: ch1, turn your work, inc in all 6st's [12]
- ➔ Fasten off WITHOUT slst and ch1 and repeat

INNER EAR

➔ using light yarn

- 1: mr, 6sc
- ➔ Fasten off WITHOUT slst and ch1 and repeat

SEWING TOGETHER

- Using sewing pins, pin parts of your work together, starting with the head and light circle, then the muzzle on top of half of the light circle

- Before sewing the ears, sew the inner ear aligned with the outer ear. Ensure that the half side is facing the head

EMBROIDERING

- Separate your 5ply black yarn into 3ply (for the eyes) and 2ply (for the nose)
