



Strawberry Earphones Holder/Cover

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CROCHET ABBREVIATIONS

ch - chain

sl st - slip stitch

sc - single crochet

hdc - half double crochet

dc - double crochet

tr - treble crochet

inc - increase

dec - decrease

blo - back loop only

flo - front loop only

st(s) - stitch(es)

[] - total stitch count

* - amount of times to repeat the stitch

MATERIALS NEEDED

5ply red milk cotton yarn

5ply white milk cotton yarn

5ply green milk cotton yarn

Darning needle

Scissors

FOR SEWING (OPTIONAL):

Fabric of any color/pattern

Sewing needle

Sewing pins

REMEMBER: slst and ch1 at the end of every stitch to start a new row!

STRAWBERRY BASE

Repeat this process twice, do not cut the yarn on the 2nd strawberry:

- 1:** (ch)*2 and turn
- 2:** starting from the 2nd ch from the hook, sc inc [2]
- 3:** (inc)*2 [4]
- 4:** inc, sc*2, inc [6]
- 5:** (sc)*6 [6]
- 6:** inc, sc*4, inc [8]
- 7:** (sc)*8 [8]
- 8:** inc, sc*6, inc [10]
- 9:** (sc)*10 [10]
- 10:** inc, sc*8, inc [12]
- 11-14:** sc in every stitch [12]
- 15:** dec, sc*8, dec [10]
- 16:** dec, sc*6, dec [8]
- 17:** dec, sc*4, dec [6]

Note: You may also crochet around the edges by ch1 and using single crochets to give the strawberry a cleaner look.

ON THE 2ND STRAWBERRY:

Change the color to green

- 1:** ch1, 6sc inbetween rows 17 of the 1st and 2nd strawberry bases

STRAWBERRY LEAVES

Change the yarn to color green. Repeat this process twice:

- 1:** ch8, 7sc
- 2:** ch5, 4sc
- 3:** slst into 2nd st
- 4:** ch5, 4sc
- 5:** slst into 4th st
- 6:** ch5, 4sc
- 7:** slst into 6th st

Cut your yarn and connect the leaves to the green section of the strawberry base

SEWING FABRIC

Put the fabric below your strawberry bases and sketch the outline



Cut the fabric & leave at least a 1cm boundary between the base. Pin the fabric & strawberry base.

Use a backstitch & fold the fabric to fit into the strawberry base.

SEWING BUTTONS

Using snap-on buttons, sew it through the fabric and the strawberry base.
