Categories:

There are 6 categories in the Angels classes:

- a. Up to 165 cm (Competitors whose height is up to 165 cm)
- b. Up to 175 cm (Competitors whose height is from 165 cm to 175 cm)
- c. Over 175 cm (Competitors whose height is over 175 cm)
- d. Masters 40+ years
- e. Masters 50+ years
- f. Masters 60+ years

Attire

A two-piece costume – wings are optional, and they do not need to be attached to the back. They may be carried while moving or attached to the arms. Avoid excessive coverage of the buttocks. Charming and creative high-heeled footwear and jewelry are encouraged. The most important elements are sparkle and glamour. Your outfit must be presented with grace and self-confidence.

The Angels class consists of one round only

When each competitor is announced, she performs the so-called “T-walk” – a walk to three marked points on the stage to ensure a smooth transition into the comparison line and create a strong first impression.

(This includes walking and several posing movements, usually 3–4 poses: front, side, and back.)

She then stands at the back of the stage and waits until all competitors have presented their outfits. The poses should be fairly relaxed; competitors should not display tense muscles.

Excessive twisting is not recommended in the front pose, and excessive bending forward is not allowed in the back pose. Competitors may also be asked to walk to the back and front of the stage so that the judges can evaluate them better.

This category is open to Fitness, Bikini, Sport Model, and Figure athletes. This is not a competition where body composition is the main focus – for example, clearly visible abdominal muscles are not required. The most important thing is what you bring to the stage: your presentation, personality, and charm.

Body Evaluation

The judging criteria are based on an overall healthy-looking, toned physique with good symmetry, shape, balance, and proportions. Posture, posing, individuality, self-confidence, and stage presence are evaluated.

Competitors should be graceful and show soft muscle definition, but they should not display excessive muscle mass or deep muscle separation.

Beauty – overall cosmetic appearance, photogenic quality, and skin tone.



Grace and Overall Impression – overall presentation, personality, self-confidence, posture, and walk.

Rules

1. There is only one judging round in this category.
2. Competitors must wear a two-piece bikini and angel wings of any style.
3. Athletes will be judged based on their overall presentation, physique, grace, and beauty on stage.
4. Angels are allowed to wear jewelry such as earrings, bracelets, and tiaras. Appropriate footwear must be worn. Each competitor will receive an overall score based on the average of all judges' scores.
5. Excessively aggressive or vulgar posing is prohibited.
6. Competitors are allowed to choose their own music for their performance.
