Congratulations, you have been selected for a Nuffic OKP Scholarship for the short course on *Resilient and Sustainable Food Systems for a Food Secure Future*, at the Wageningen Centre for Development Innovation (WCDI).

The course will take place from 18 March through 26 April 2024. This is a blended course, which means that the course will be held partially online and partially on location in Rwanda, from April 18 through April 24 2024 (five days).

WCDI has been assigned by Nuffic to administer your scholarship. As an OKP scholarship holder, there are a few practical issues that need your attention.

The OKP Scholarship

The OKP scholarship is financed by the Dutch Ministry of Foreign Affairs from the budget for development cooperation. The scholarship is meant as a compensation of the costs involved in participating in a short course organised by WCDI. Please be aware that the OKP scholarship is not a full coverage of all costs that may be involved.

Your OKP scholarship is composed of the following:

- Tuition fee for the short course
- Online course/interactive e-learning
- Access to our Learning Management System Curatr
- Full board and lodging at venue in Rwanda (arranged by WCDI)
- International air travel (arranged by WCDI)
- Airport tax duties (if applicable)
- AON health insurance in Rwanda (arranged by WCDI)
- Study allowance: € 35,-
- Compensation for VISA costs: € 80,-

Other costs

The following costs are not covered by the scholarship:

- Local travel in your home country
- Transportation from airport in Rwanda to hotel and return
- Any personal expenses

By accepting the OKP scholarship, you agree with the conditions mentioned in the: 'Obligations for OKP Scholarship Holders'. Please read the document carefully.

VISA

You may require a visa for Rwanda. At visaindex.com you can find more information about visa requirements. You will have to apply for the visa yourself.

After accepting your OKP scholarship and confirming your availability, WCDI will send you the following items:

- provisional e-ticket
- AON insurance certificate
- hotel confirmation letter

Together with this invitation letter, you can apply for a visa.


