# Accommodations

#### **Hotels:**

Because Haverford is a smaller school, there aren't a lot of large hotels extremely close to campus. Because of this, we have secured a group rate for a hotel about 12-15 minutes away from campus. # Fairfield by Marriott Inn & Suites Philadelphia Broomall/Newtown Square

- Marriott Philadelphia West (111 Crawford Ave, West Conshohocken, PA 19428), 5.6 miles, about 15 min drive
- **Hilton Garden Inn Newtown Square Radnor** (3743 West Chester Pike, Newtown Square, PA 19073), 6.7 miles, about 17 min drive
- Residence Inn by Marriott Philadelphia Conshohocken (191 Washington St, Conshohocken, PA 19428), 7.1 miles, about 18 min drive

# **GETTING HERE**

### **Public Transportation**

If you are taking a train, you will likely come into 30th Street Station. You can transfer there to another line. Our local transit system is SEPTA. Please visit the <u>SEPTA website</u> or Maps to plan your trip accordingly. Haverford College is conveniently located at the intersection of two different lines. The nearest Regional Rail stations are Haverford and Ardmore. The nearest Norristown High Speed Line is Haverford Road. If you're coming from Philadelphia, we recommend the Regional Rail line and getting off at the Haverford stop.

### **Parking**

There are a number of places to park on campus during the weekend. We recommend the south lot, which is the main lot on campus (follow the signs for "admissions parking"). There are also a few other parking locations, but please be aware that you're parking in an area that isn't reserved for faculty or students.
