Welcome to the Oronoque Village Pickleball Club (OVPC). We are an active club with members at all levels of play – beginner through advanced – and are as active on the courts as we are socially, with many fun events scheduled throughout the year. While the Village's five outdoor hard-surface courts are open to all residents, club members receive additional benefits such as: dedicated court time, access to paddles and balls, opportunities to attend clinics, take lessons and play in tournaments (if desired), and use of the digital application TeamReach to sign up to play with other members.

Mission Statement for OV Pickleball Club:

The Oronoque Village Pickleball Club's mission is to promote exercise and community by organizing pickleball play and hosting social events.

Club Playtime Sign Up:

When you become a member you will download the free app **TeamReach** (accessible on your phone) and be provided with our **club code** to request to join the OVPC site. Once you have been granted access, you will be able to see the date/time club playtime is scheduled, sign up to play, and see names of other members signed up. Residents who are not OVPC members may use the courts during non-club schedule playtime.

Where to Buy Equipment:

While we have paddles and balls for club members to use, which are stored in the shed at the courts, most members purchase their own paddles once they begin to play regularly. The club has been buying equipment at pickleballcentral.com where members receive a 5% discount. Codes are below.

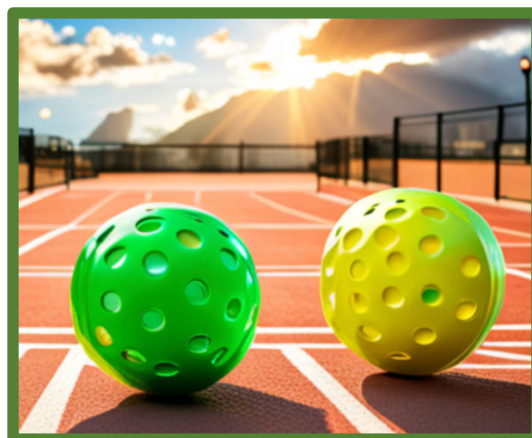
