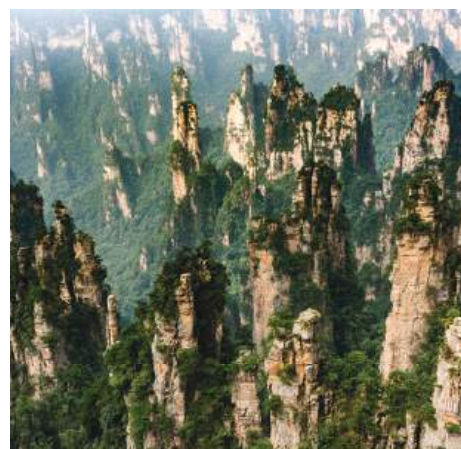

📍 Hiroshima, Miyajima

## Day 1 Hiroshima – Arrival

Arrive in Hiroshima, transfer to the hotel and check in for the stay. The rest of the day is at leisure.

## Day 2 Hiroshima – Miyajima – Hiroshima (B)

In the morning, head to Miyajimaguchi port and take the ferry to Miyajima. Visit Itsukushima Shrine, a World Heritage site established in the 6th Century. This shrine is renowned for its Shinden-zukuri style structure, framed by the green of Mt. Misen and the blue Seto Sea. Enjoy some local delicacies like oysters, Hiroshima-style okonomiyaki, and conger eel rice bowl during your leisure lunch. In the afternoon, return to Hiroshima and visit the Peace Memorial Park and Hiroshima Peace Memorial Museum. The park, established in 1949, is a symbol of peace, and the museum serves as a reminder of the horrors of atomic bombs. Finally, visit the Atomic Bomb Dome, a preserved symbol of the devastation from WWII, promoting peace and the elimination of nuclear weapons.

## Day 3 Hiroshima – Departure (B)

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and proceed to the next destination independently.

On the summit lie remnants of a royal palace, water tanks, and guard buildings. Along the ascent, discover the famous frescoes of 21 life-size figures, the only known example of ancient Sinhala secular painting. Explore the archaeological complex, including the Water Gardens, Fountain Garden, Boulder Gardens, and Caves. Afterwards, continue to Dambulla, renowned for its five cave temples carved into a rock. The first three caves, larger and older, date back to the 1st century BCE. Admire the intricate Buddhist murals adorning the cave walls and ceilings, as well as over 130 Buddha statues and depictions of Gods and Kings. Return to the hotel for the evening, with the rest of the day at leisure.

### Day 4 Habarana – Kandy (B)

After breakfast, begin the journey to Kandy, approximately a 2.5-hour drive. Upon arrival, visit the Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic, an important shrine housing the relic of Lord Buddha's tooth. This revered relic is displayed in a two-story shrine, flanked by large elephant tusks, and rests on a golden lotus flower within a jewel-encrusted box on a throne. Continue to the Peradeniya Botanical Garden, located on the outskirts of Kandy. Established in 1371 as a retreat for a Kandyan queen, the garden is encircled on three sides by the Mahaweli River. In the early 1800s, it became one of the premier botanical gardens of the British Empire and briefly served as the Allied Forces Headquarters during World War II. In the evening, experience a Kandyan cultural show featuring traditional dance, acrobatics, vibrant costumes, and music. These performances celebrate the rich heritage of the region, showcasing art forms once native to Kandy but now an integral part of Sri Lankan culture.

### Day 5 Kandy – Beruwala (B)

After breakfast, depart for Beruwala, a journey of approximately 3.5 hours by road. Upon arrival, check in to the hotel and take some time to relax and unwind. Today, travel to Pisa and take a tourist train to the Piazza Dei Miracoli to admire the iconic Leaning Tower of Pisa. Then, head to the Ligurian Coast, known for its breathtaking scenery, and visit the Cinque Terre, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. This area



consists of five villages, largely isolated by road and dependent on fishing and tourism. Travel by train to Vernazza, where the historic Church of Santa Margarita, built in 1318, can be explored. Afterwards, take the train to Levanto and rejoin the coach to continue to Genoa.

Note: The train to Cinque Terre is a regular local railway service, not a tourist service. Sometimes the trains are full (no reservations allowed), so it might be necessary, on occasion, to travel standing and not sitting down.

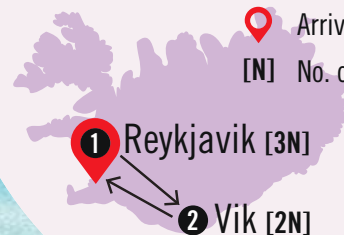
