<u>SB</u> <u>345</u>	Keith Murphy	Title: relative to state park fees for state residents. Comments Floor amendment pushed out the effective date to April 2025. Seeks to require resident fees for use of state parks be no more than 50% of nonresident fees. It also would permit DNCR to set different rates for residents and nonresidents for any given service within the state park but cap resident fees at up to 90% of nonresident fees for the same services. Comments  Completely changes the bill which sought to set the maximum THC concentration for driving under the influence of drugs offenses for all motor vehicles including OHRVs. 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<u>SB</u> 426	Gannon	Title: relative to the possession of controlled drugs in motor vehicles.  Comments  The amendment would make it clear it would allow the possession of therapeutic cannabis and add glove box to the list of places not easily accessible to the operator. Attempts to clarify the allowable possession of certain cannabis products in a motor vehicle or OHRV and requiring them to be in a secure container that is the least accessible location for the driver. <u>SB</u> <u>471</u>	Watters	Title: relative to adding a speed limit of 45 miles per hour on rural highways. Comments Introduced to address an issue on Route 4 in Rollinsford. DOT made it clear this would be done in limited circumstances and with town approval. Would limit speed limits to 45 miles per hour in a newly defined "unimproved rural highway". <u>SB</u> 491	<u>Jeb</u> <u>Bradley</u>	Title: (New Title) relative to authorizing legislative bodies of municipalities to enter into voluntary agreements with owners of private roads.  Comments  The amendment changes to the approval to by the legislative body. Would allow municipalities to enter into agreements with owners of private roads to allow for municipal use of the road. An agreement would need the written consent of every owner on the road, could not obligate the town to maintain the road, and clearly specify the types of uses are allowed and which parties are responsible for road maintenance.
