Summary: This tool is a desktop application built using PyQt 6 designed to perform stemming and morphological analysis for Punjabi shahmukhi script. The application consists of two main functions: a morphological analyser that breaks down words into prefixes, roots and suffixes, and a stemmer that applies predefined rules to find the stem of a word, avoiding stemming for specific common words.
