



REVIEW OF LESSON 3: LOOKING AT SCRIPTURE

HOLY SPIRIT

John 16:12-15 (LSB)

¹² "I still have many more things to say to you, but you cannot bear them now. ¹³ But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth; for He will not speak from Himself, but whatever He hears, He will speak; and He will disclose to you what is to come. ¹⁴ He will glorify Me, for He will take of Mine and will disclose it to you. ¹⁵ All things that the Father has are Mine; therefore I said that He takes of Mine and will disclose it to you.

1 Corinthians 2:10-16 (ESV)

¹⁰ these things God has revealed to us through the Spirit. For the Spirit searches everything, even the depths of God. ¹¹ For who knows a person's thoughts except the spirit of that person, which is in him? So also no one comprehends the thoughts of God except the Spirit of God. ¹² Now we have received not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might understand the things freely given us by God.



¹³ And we impart this in words not taught by human wisdom but taught by the Spirit, interpreting spiritual truths to those who are spiritual.

¹⁴ The natural person does not accept the things of the Spirit of God, for they are folly to him, and he is not able to understand them because they are spiritually discerned.

1 Corinthians 12:1-3

¹ Now concerning spiritual gifts, brethren, I do not want you to be ignorant: ² You know that you were Gentiles, carried away to these dumb idols, however you were led. ³ Therefore I make known to you that no one speaking by the Spirit of God calls Jesus accursed, and no one can say that Jesus is Lord except by the Holy Spirit.

Hence without the illumination of the Spirit the word has no effect; and hence also it is obvious that faith is something higher than human understanding. Nor were it sufficient for the mind to be illumined by the Spirit of God unless the heart also were strengthened and supported by his power.



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



PRAYER

Psalm 119:17-18 (NKJV) ¹⁷ Deal bountifully with Your servant, That I may live and keep Your word. ¹⁸ Open my eyes, that I may see Wondrous things from Your law.


It is declared by *opening of our eyes*, <u>Ps. cxix. 18</u>; *the enlightening of the eyes of our understanding*, <u>Eph. i. 18</u>. This opening of our eyes consists in the communication of spiritual light unto our minds by the preaching of the word, as it is declared, <u>Acts xxvi. 17, 18</u>.

And the expression, though in part *metaphorical*, is eminently instructive in the nature of this work; for suppose the nearest and best-disposed proposition of any object unto our bodily eyes, with an external light properly suited unto the discovery of it, yet if our *eyes be blind*, or are closed beyond our own power to *open* them, we cannot discern it aright.

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HOLY SPIRIT AND PRAYER - OWEN

"What we are proving is that there is more required for a useful apprehension and understanding of the mind of God in the Scripture, than the mere objective proposal of it to us, and our diligent use of outward means to come to the knowledge of it. Yet, as we will show, this is from the Holy Spirit also.

HOLY SPIRIT AND PRAYER - OWEN

The denial of this, by just consequence, voids the principal means by which we may come to such an understanding — namely, frequent and fervent prayers for the aid and assistance of the Holy Spirit. So too, no tolerable account can be given of the mind of God and the meaning of the Scripture in the passages insisted on."
