Melvin Güivas, globally recognized as **COPEZERO**, stands as a pioneering Drum & Bass DJ and producer from Puerto Rico. Renowned for his technical prowess and electrifying performances, as **COPEZERO** has forged a path as one of the island's most influential figures in electronic music.

Biography

A cornerstone of Puerto Rico's Drum & Bass scene since the late 1990s, **COPEZERO** is recognized for his visionary energy behind the decks and a career defined by boundary-pushing sets alongside some of the world's most legendary DJs. He became the first DJ to have a weekly Drum & Bass residency in Puerto Rico, which hosted some of the best DJs from back in the day, including The Usual Suspects and J-Majik to name a few.

Over more than two decades, he has shared the stage with giants of the genre—including Andy C, Ed Rush & Optical, Bad Company UK, Friction, Black Sun Empire, The Upbeats, North Base, Makoto, State Of Mind, LTJ Bukem, and Calyx & Teebee—earning a reputation as the island’s Drum & Bass ambassador.

COPEZERO’s devotion to elevating the soundtracks of underground nightlife is matched by a creative partnership with Grammy-winning* producer and engineer Egy Rodz. Known for their forward-thinking collaborations and a catalog of unreleased original tracks, this duo continually redefines the local scene’s possibilities while connecting Puerto Rican Drum & Bass to a global audience. As a spearhead of QVLQV and the legendary Korrosive Crew—Puerto Rico’s leading Drum & Bass event collectives—**COPEZERO** has also been instrumental in bringing legendary acts The World of Drum & Bass to the island and curating events that have shaped generations of ravers.

Relentlessly passionate, always evolving, but deeply rooted in Drum & Bass tradition, **COPEZERO** continues to inspire, elevate, and connect dancefloors across cultures.

Throughout his career, **COPEZERO** has brought electrifying Drum & Bass energy not only to world-renowned clubs but also to some of the most iconic outdoor venues of the underground scene. Early on, he made his mark by performing at Puerto Rico's legendary El Tunel De Guajataca—an historical coastal tunnel known for its breathtaking views and vibrant cultural history—where he shared the stage with global electronic pioneer Paul Oakenfold. This milestone event helped cement his reputation as a leading force in the island's open-air rave movement.

Beyond countless headline appearances throughout Puerto Rico, **COPEZERO**'s reach extends internationally, having performed across the US, Europe, and South America. His sets are celebrated for their signature heavy basslines, unrelenting tempo, and the willingness to ignite dancefloors with exclusive, unreleased material.

COPEZERO's international reach extends to Europe, where he was featured at Fort Gorgast in Germany as part of the Oderbruch Open Air (OBOA) Fest, a celebrated and long-running free outdoor festival that draws thousands of music lovers each year. These performances at landmark outdoor sites reflect his passion for uniting diverse audiences under the sky and his enduring role in elevating the live electronic experience on a global scale. Recently, he performed on the iconic club La Tangente in Buenos Aires, Argentina, alongside his old friends DJ Silver and Wilf Profecy from the UK duo North Base.

He has also being a guest on several FM Drum & Bass radio shows in Leicester (Unity Radio 92.8FM - England), Lille (RCV 99.0 - France) and Cardiff (Radio Cardiff 98.7FM - Wales).

Through his club residencies, exclusive events, and weekly shows, he has nurtured the Puerto Rican D&B and Dubstep communities—spotlighting emerging talent and introducing groundbreaking sounds.
- **Dubstep Pioneer:**
In 2007, **COPEZERO** along his partner in crime, Moshrum, formed PRDC (Puerto Rico Dubstep Crew) and delivered Puerto Rico's first **Dubstep** showcases, preparing local audiences for the global bass revolution.

COPEZERO is celebrated for genre-defiant mixes: seamlessly blending deep Drum & Bass, Jungle, Dubstep, and other cutting-edge electronic flavors. His sets are known for captivating dancefloors, blending technical skill with true crowd connection.
