



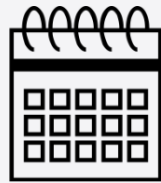

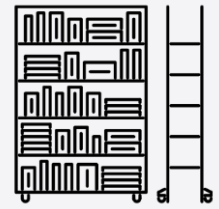

A huge thank you to all our families for supporting us this term – and particularly to all the wonderful members of our Wyton School and Community Association.

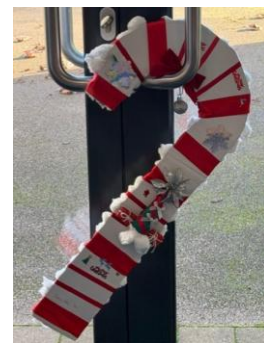
It has been fantastic to see so many parents and carers in school over the past few weeks, sharing our various events and performances with us.

Last but not least, thanks to all those families who supported our Eco-school Christmas decoration competition – recycling has never looked to festive!





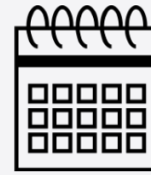
Sadly, we must say goodbye to the brilliant Miss Gowler today, as she leaves us to start a new adventure in the new year...

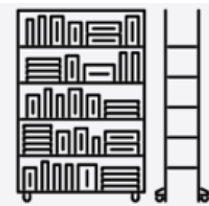


