





We are excited to be holding our whole school poetry performance to celebrate World Book Day again on Thursday 6th March.

All classes from Reception to Year 6 will be sharing a poem they have studied with you, our lovely audience.

Our performance assembly will begin at 9.15am.

As in previous years, in celebration of the power and joy of books, we are asking children to send in a photo of themselves reading their books - if they would like to. These will be shared in the assembly.

On World Book Day, children will also be invited to bring their favourite book into school to read with a partner and to dress as a character from a book they love – if they wish.

Our next 'Meet the teacher' and 'Book Look' session has been booked for **Wednesday**, 1st **March from 3.30 - 4.45pm.**

As well as providing parents with the opportunity to meet informally with their child's class teacher this half term, this event offers an ideal opportunity for you to explore your child's classroom and look at your children's books / learning with your child, with class teachers on hand to answer any queries you may have about any aspect of school life this term.

Our next Parent Consultations will be held on Tuesday 1st April (3.30 – 7pm) and Thursday 3rd April (3.30 – 5pm) and appointment slots will be available to book online in the week after half term, when Mr Tuxworth will send you a link via email.

Please note that we are changing the way we book our appointments to a 'first come, first served' system: as soon as you have requested your preferred time slots, you will receive an appointment slip. If your preferred slots have already been booked by others, we will make an appointment for you as near to your chosen time slot as possible.

Unfortunately, we will not be able to change appointment times once booked – though you may exchange your appointment in agreement with another parent if you so wish.

- Counting the birds in our grounds to see if we have managed to attract increased populations or new species.




Governing Body news...
