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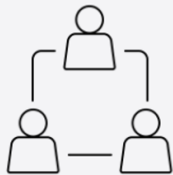
We are excited to be holding our whole school poetry performance to celebrate World Book Day again.

On World Book Day, children will also be invited to bring their favourite book into school to read with a partner and to dress as a character from a book they love – if they wish.

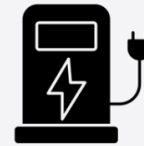


Appointments for our next Parent Consultations on 1st & 3rd of April will be available to book online from 6pm this evening.

As you will be aware from our last newsletter, our next Parent Consultations will be held on **Tuesday 1st April (3.30 – 7pm) and Thursday 3rd April (3.30 – 5pm)** and appointment slots will be available to book online from 6pm using the link already sent to you by Mr Tuxworth via email.

Please remember that we are changing the way we book our appointments to a ‘first come, first served’ system: as soon as you have requested your preferred time slots, you will receive an appointment slip. If your preferred slots have already been booked by others, we will make an appointment for you as near to your chosen time slot as possible.

Unfortunately, we will not be able to change appointment times once booked – though you may exchange your appointment in agreement with another parent if you so wish. **If you decide to do this, please notify Mrs Treston in the school office so that she can inform teaching staff!**



We now have two electric car charging points in our car park for community use– please avoid parking there unless you are charging your car.

The two parking bays are just next to the disabled parking spot near the school office and can be paid for via a charging app. There is a QR code on the stand which takes you to the app.

Projects this half term will include:

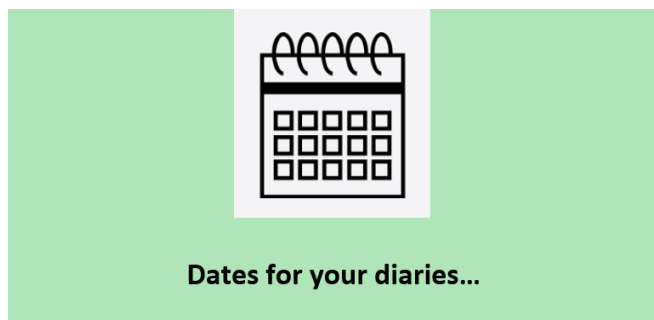
- Litter-picking as part of our ongoing Eco-schools commitment

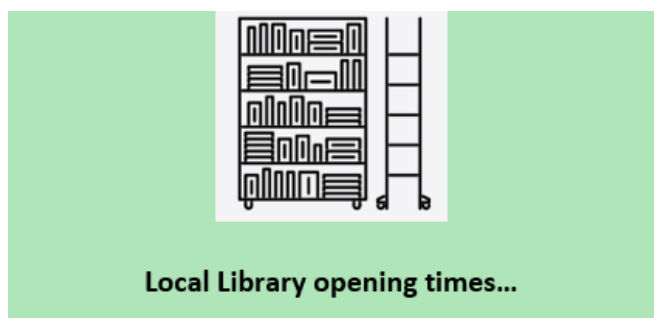
