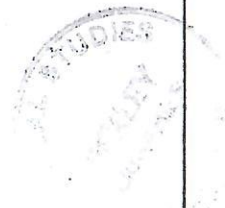

BRIEF ACCOUNT.

For some years it had been in the minds of Lord and Lady Waring, who have resided in the district at Foots Cray Place for the past 30 years, that there was a need for a Park for recreation and games for the inhabitants of the locality.

Some two years ago they put their wishes in a concrete form by most generously presenting to the district an area of about 12 acres, subject to the Council agreeing to lay out and maintain it as a park and playing field in perpetuity.

The Council, with the co-operation of the Lord St. David's Unemployment Committee, have been able to lay out the area with a level playing field of about 8 acres, plant borders with trees and shrubs, which will be in bloom practically throughout the year, and build six shelters, two sets of lavatories, and a store shed of brick with Norfolk reed thatching. A space of woodland with fully grown trees and underwood is also provided. The cost of the lay-out to the local rates at the present time is less than $\frac{1}{2}$ d. in the £.

The lay-out has been considerably helped by a gift of land from Mr. T. J. Robins, a gift of two drinking fountains from the Metropolitan Drinking Fountain and Cattle Trough Association, and by donations towards the cost of turfing from the National Playing Fields' Association, the Kent County Playing Fields' Association and the Carnegie Trustees.

The whole of the formation was carried out by workmen under the direct supervision of the Council's Surveyor, Mr. W. A. Farnham, and the buildings erected by Messrs. W. Harbrow (1928), Ltd., to the plans and under the supervision of Mr. K. Dalgliesh, A.R.I.B.A.

Pitches are being reserved for matches by local clubs, and during the coming summer games have been arranged by the Sidcup Cricket Club, the Sidcupgas Sports Club, the Sidcup Police, etc.

The Park is conveniently and centrally situated and, it is hoped, will provide facilities for the enjoyment of both the older and younger members of the community.

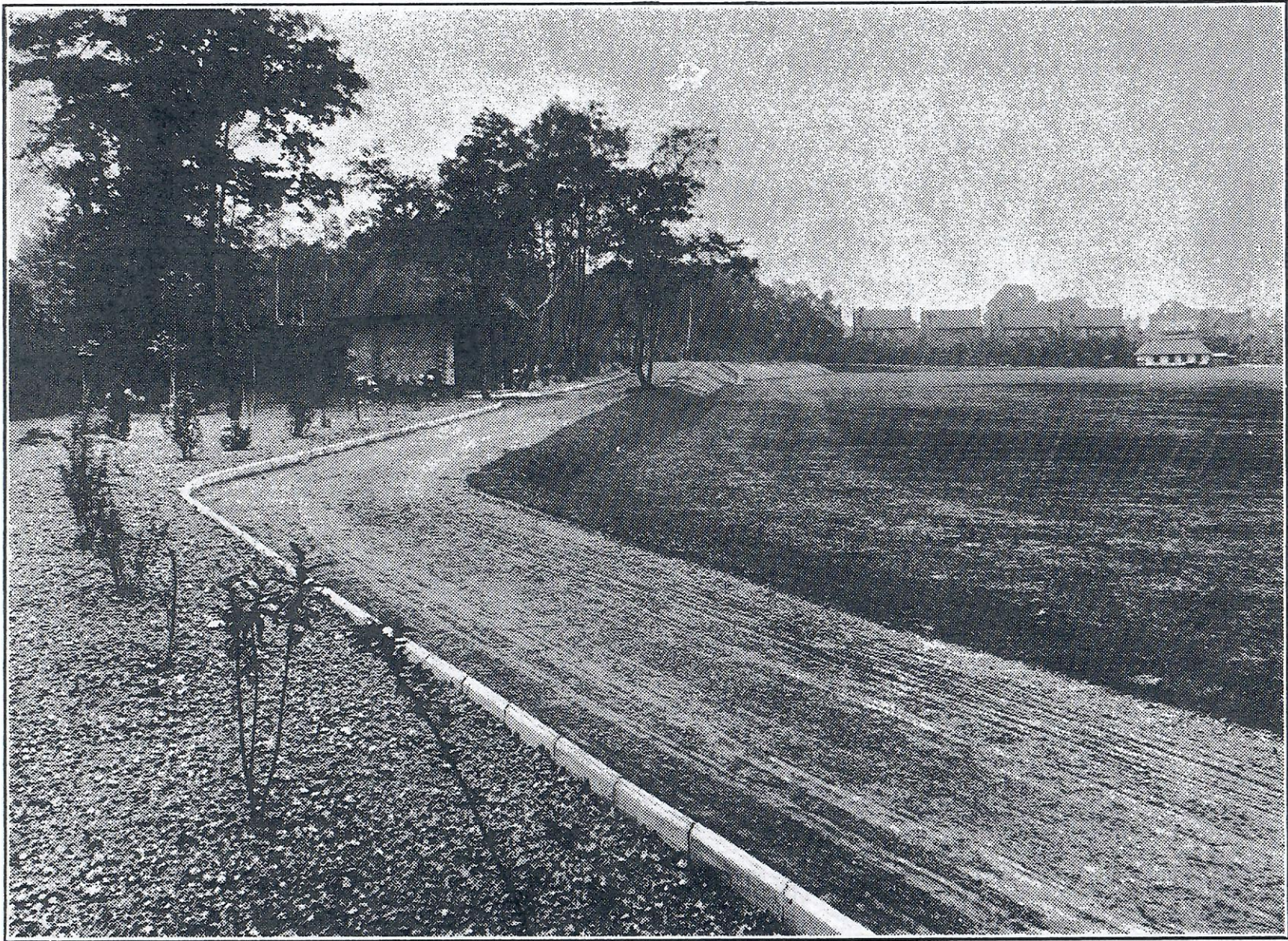
