Models will increasingly support judgment — highlighting trade-offs, risks, and second-order effects, not just outputs.


Finance teams will use AI to:

Finance functions will operate in continuous scenario mode:


- baseline,

Finance will lead the shift toward AI governance in practice, not policy PDFs.



Expect:


