

Director of Music – Traditional (Part-Time)
20-25 hours/week | Sundays & Special Services
Position Open: September 7, 2025

Key Responsibilities:

- Plan and coordinate traditional music for Sunday 10:30am worship and special services with Pastor (7 different pieces - Prelude, 3 hymns, Anthem/Solo, Offertory, Postlude; 2 repeated pieces - *Gloria Patri* and the Doxology)
- Organist: Provide piano and/or organ (Rodgers, three manual) accompaniment for hymns, anthems, and service music.
- Director: Direct the Chancel Choir (15-19 voices, currently rehearse Sunday mornings September-June) and Handbell Ensemble (5 octaves, currently rehearse one weekday September-May). Includes 4 choral scholars (Soprano, Alto, Tenor, Bass).
- Maintain and develop the church's music library and instruments.
- Attend worship planning meetings and collaborate with staff and volunteers.
- Assist with music for weddings, funerals, and memorial services when available for extra compensation.
- *This position may be considered on an Interim basis and may be split into two roles: organist and director of choirs, depending on candidates.

Qualifications:

- Experience in church music direction, choral leadership, and accompanying on organ and piano.
- Knowledge of traditional church music, liturgy, and hymnody.
- Strong organizational and communication skills.
- A degree in music or formal training is preferred.
- Familiarity with Christian faith and Presbyterian worship practices is a plus.
