Job Interview Questions

1. Do you have any work experience?
2. Why are you looking for a job?
3. Why did you decide to apply for a job with us?
4. How do you handle stress at work?
5. Why do you think you're right for the job?
6. Can you work overtime?
7. How will you get to work? Do you have a car?
8. When can you start working?



2. **ASSESS** Tell another pair of students which job you chose and present the interview to them. The other pair watches the interview, takes notes and gives you feedback based on the Feedback Guidelines.

Feedback Guidelines

1. Was the applicant polite?
 - a. Did he or she shake the interviewer's hand?
 - b. Did he or she make eye contact with the interviewer?
 - c. Did he or she use polite language?
2. Did the applicant give detailed answers? Explain.
3. Do you think the applicant is right for the job? Explain.
