- We ask that ambassadors commit to the program for a minimum of 12 months, with the possibility of extending the role beyond graduation in some cases.

- A Strong sense of civic duty, a passion for community development and an understanding of global and current issues.
- Youth from diverse ethnic, religious and national backgrounds.

**About the Global South Centre :** Inaugurated in June 2023 at Vanijya Bhawan by 4 Union Ministers in presence of diplomats from 54 countries, the Centre strengthens India's ties with the Global South nations by promoting economic, social, and cultural cooperation. It seeks to advance the region's development prospects and global presence through its dedicated working groups. Under Working Group 5, the Chamber focuses on engaging the youth of the Global South in cultural exchange and diplomacy.

To further this mission, **Chamber India is launching the International Youth Ambassador Program 2025**, offering students a platform to represent Chamber India in their institutions and engage in discussions with the global audience.

## FAQs

### ● What's the purpose of this programme?

This programme is designed to provide students with global exposure through discussions, meetings, and deliberations. It's a space to discuss ideas, meet inspiring people, and engage in conversations about global and national topics.

### ● Will there be any stipend or monetary benefit?

No, this is a voluntary programme with no stipend. However, select ambassadors may have the opportunity for a paid internship with Chamber India after completing the programme.

### ● Do selected candidates need to make any payments or cover any expenses?

No, Youth Ambassadors are not required to bear any expenses or make any payments. If an event requires travel beyond usual limits, the Chamber will reimburse the travel expenses.

### ● Will this affect my studies?

Not at all. This programme is 100% voluntary. We'll invite you to events and discussions, but it's up to you to decide how much you want to participate. Academics always come first.

### ● What activities are part of this programme?

- Virtual meetings with representatives from India and other countries has been planned for the academic year.
- Chamber has also planned quarterly in-person meetings in different states with national and international guests to enhance learning and networking.

### ● What are the benefits of the programme?

### ● Is this a 100% voluntary programme?

Yes. There are no mandatory tasks. Ambassadors contribute at their convenience, adding value to Chamber India, the country, and society.

### ● Will there be opportunities to contribute to policy discussions?

Yes. We plan to create a policy document focused on youth and submit it to the Ministry of Finance and Ministry of Youth Affairs. Youth Ambassadors will have the opportunity to participate in discussions and provide inputs for such policy recommendations.

*For example: Youth Ambassadors can contribute to a policy document addressing the lack of subsidized youth hostels in metropolitan cities for meritorious students, artists, and those pursuing unconventional career paths.*

### ● What is the business of Chamber India?
