If you would like to help with any of our activities or events, please do get in touch.

You can volunteer as much or as little time as you wish on a flexible basis.

Some of our activities include:

- · producing and distributing our free, community magazine
- regular litter picks throughout the PL24 postcode
- making bags out of recycled material and giving them away free, so as to minimise the use of plastic bags under the Morsbags scheme
- gardening and maintaining various planters and green spaces in PL24
- meeting members of the community on the PL24CA stand at local events, listening to their ideas and promoting PL24CA
- managing a popular Facebook group
- applying for funding to improve the quality of life for all in our area e.g., we have put up an
  information board and map at Par Railway Station and donated benches to enable more
  people to get out and about and socialise.
- developing our website at <u>pl24community.org/</u>
- supporting local businesses by advertising their presence both on Facebook and in PL24 Magazine, so encouraging people to "buy local"
- refurbishing and painting council owned benches and other assets
- listening to the community and building on suggestions for how we might improve the quality of life for all in PL24.

We do run other activities from time to time but it all comes down to our volunteer capacity. So, do please let us know if you think you would be able to help in any way.

If you do want to use your car, van or any other vehicle for PL24CA activities e.g., for transporting a gazebo, please ensure that you have current volunteer insurance in place for your vehicle, you have the appropriate driving licence and that your vehicle has a current MOT.
