Reading

Children should be reading books which they understand but which introduce them to new language – if they know every word, the book is probably too easy; if they are struggling to get through each page without help, it is probably too hard.

Please remember that when we say we have 'read' a book we should mean we have read, understood and can explain about the various characters, plots and sub-plots of the book. Being able to simply sound the words out on the page is <u>not</u> reading! Additionally you should know who wrote the book. Below are some suggested books to help improve vocabulary. Some are harder than others and some may not be on a topic which you may enjoy so choose carefully and once you have decided upon a book, read it carefully and completely. Deciding a book is 'boring' once you have begun probably means it's difficult! Don't give up! None of the books below is 'abridged' and the difficulty ratings are simply my personal opinion.
