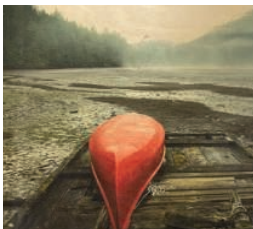
As we near the end of 2025, the Blackberry Artists' Society would like to wish everyone a joy filled holiday season and the very best for the year ahead.

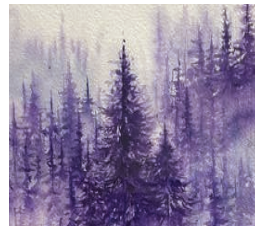
HIGHLIGHTS FOR THE NEW YEAR Shop Re-fresh
