.....we have to have good conservative, America First local Republican parties.



What is a Precinct and Why do they Matter?

SC consists of 46 counties. Each county consists of precincts. The Dorchester County Republican party is organized into 81 precincts. This matters to YOU because each precinct can elect leaders who represent the people that live within that precinct (usually between 500-3000 residents).

New leadership is elected in the odd years, or the non-election years. This process is called "Reorganization". Leaders are elected at the Precinct level, the County level and the State level.

It is very easy to get involved at this grass-roots level. It just takes one night to show up, meet those who want to serve as leaders, and if you like what you hear, vote for them.

How Do I Find My Precinct?

- Go to <u>scvotes.gov</u>
- Go to Voters -> Check your Voter Registration
- Enter the personal information requested
- See "Precinct" (example shown)

Is This the Department of Public Health We Want?

In our last newsletter, we let you know that on 11/19/24, Governor McMaster announced that he is appointing the former DHEC director, Dr. Edward Simmer, to permanently lead the South Carolina Department of Public Health (DPH). Simmer's appointment is pending Senate confirmation.

Listen to this Palmetto State Watch (PSW) article in which PSW compiled a highlight reel of Simmer's policies during SC's response to COVID-19 which included:

- Encouraged bribery with incentives like free drinks at bars and free admission to parks/ fairs
- Deployed mobile units to parks and fairs to push the vaccine
- Encouraged 12 year olds and up to be vaccinated and considered it a 'big plus' that the vaccine was later available for ages 5-11
- Recommended boosters
- (Strongly) recommended vaccines for pregnant women
- Pushed for masking (unless you were vaccinated)
- Pushed for a goal of over 70% of SC to be vaccinated
- Believed that science shows that school children should be masked

Also, read this PSW article that includes a letter from a parent to the SC Senate Medical Affairs Committee.

Do you believe this is the right person for the job if we face another pandemic? Will Simmer be on board with the "Make America Healthy Again (MAHA)" platform?

If you think we deserve better, call Governor Henry McMaster at 803-734-2100 and ask him to withdraw this appointment. Also contact your SC State Senator and ask them to vote 'No' on Simmer's appointment.
