RITE OF PASSAGE

"A ceremony or event marking an important stage in someone's life, especially the transition from childhood to adulthood.

It involves a significant change of status in society."

Whilst we can still find examples of these rites today, we have largely forgotten this ancient tradition within our western culture.

FOR THE SOCIETY & THE CHILD

This tradition ensured that when the child returned from the rite, they would not be treated the same again.

However, most importantly, the child believed within its heart and soul that they had crossed the threshold into adulthood.

STAGES OF THE RITE

SEPARATION

STAGES OF THE RITE

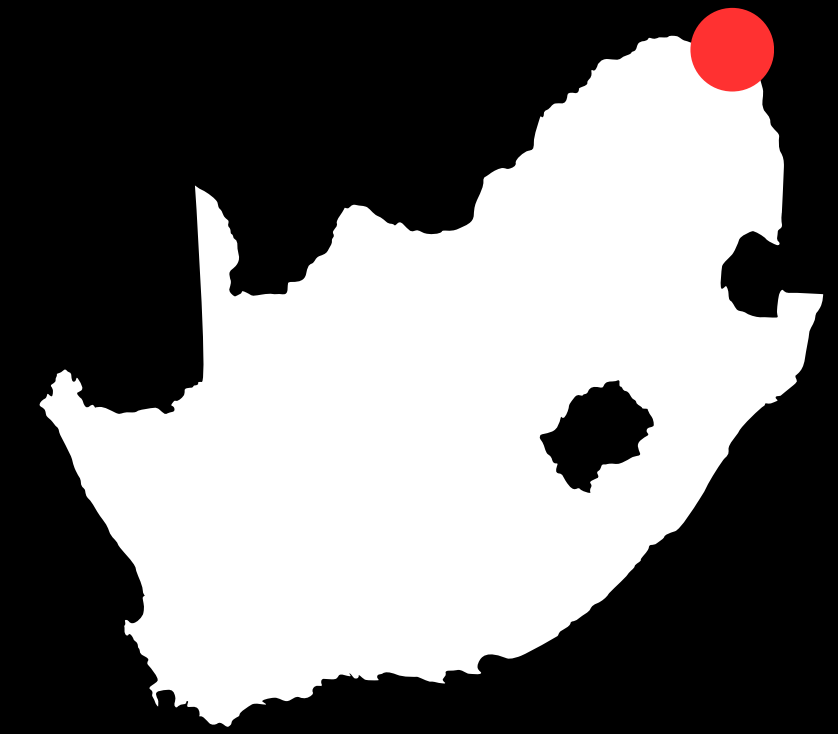
RETURN

- The public can't access and only very limited vehicles allowed - one of the truly wild areas still remaining
- Owned by Makuleke people have been tribal grounds for thousands of years


