



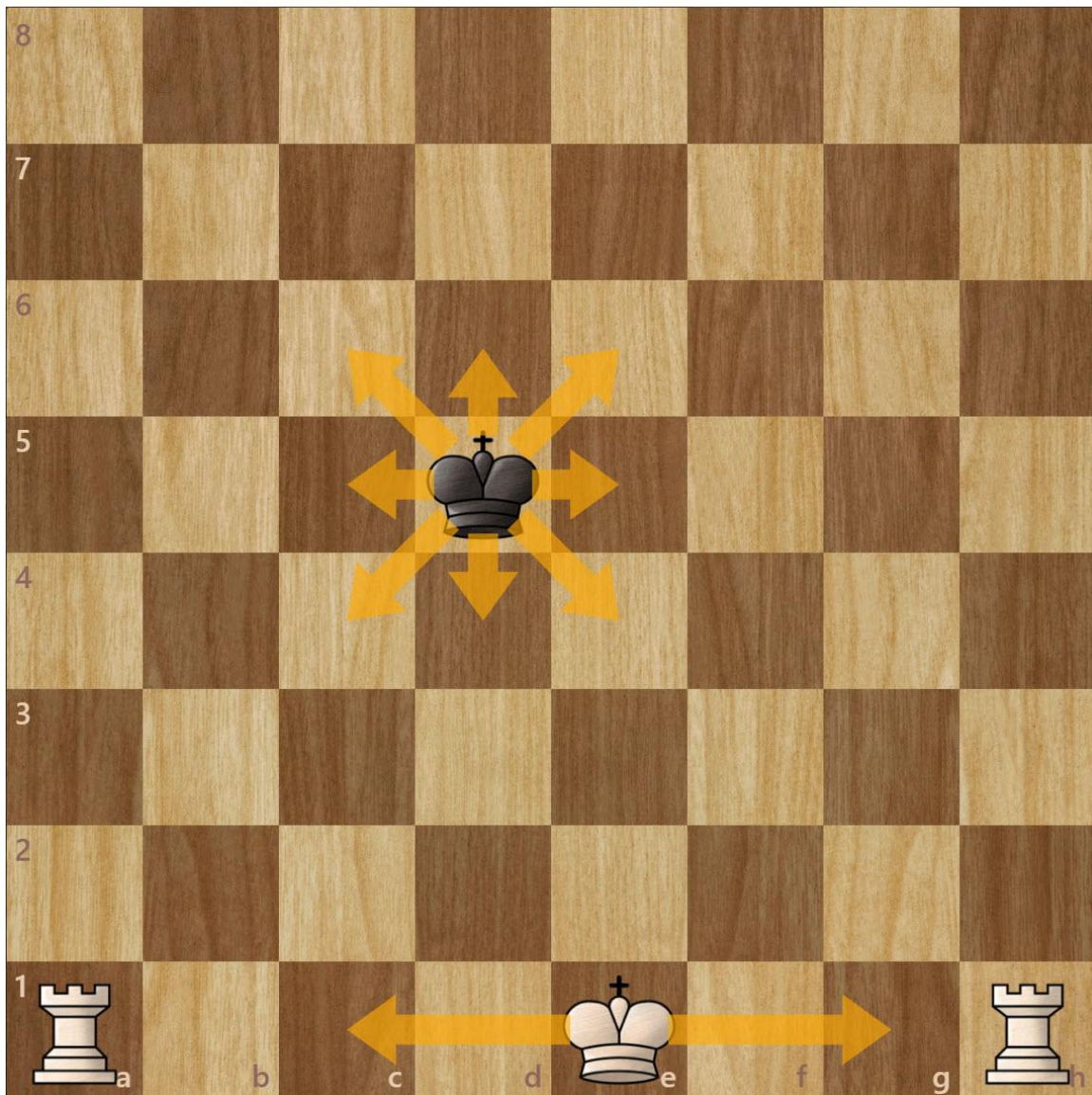

How Chess Pieces Move

### The King (K)

The King moves one step in any direction

**Exception:** When the King castles, he moves two squares either to his right or left side.



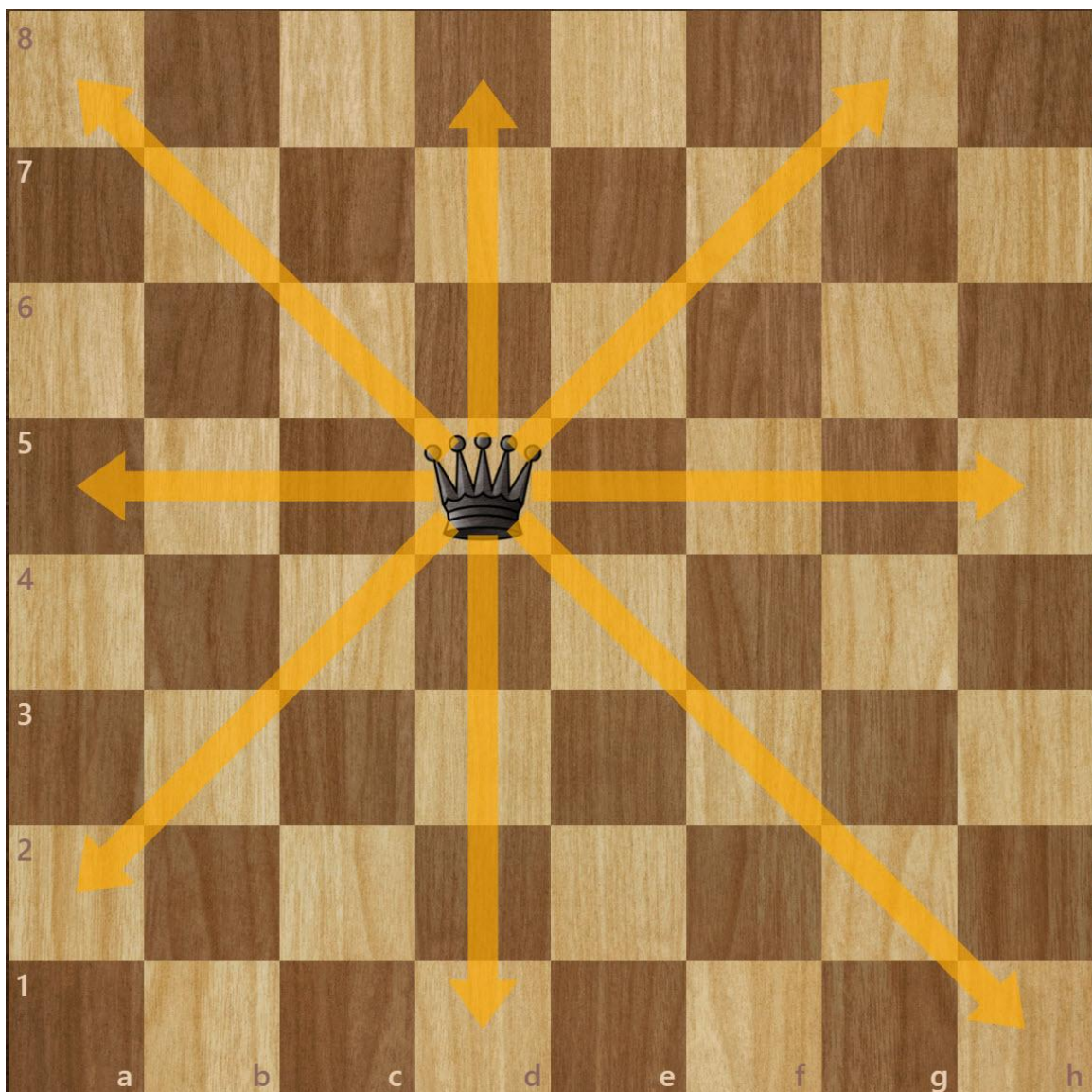

How Chess Pieces Move

### The Queen (Q)

The Queen moves in any direction and as many squares as she likes.





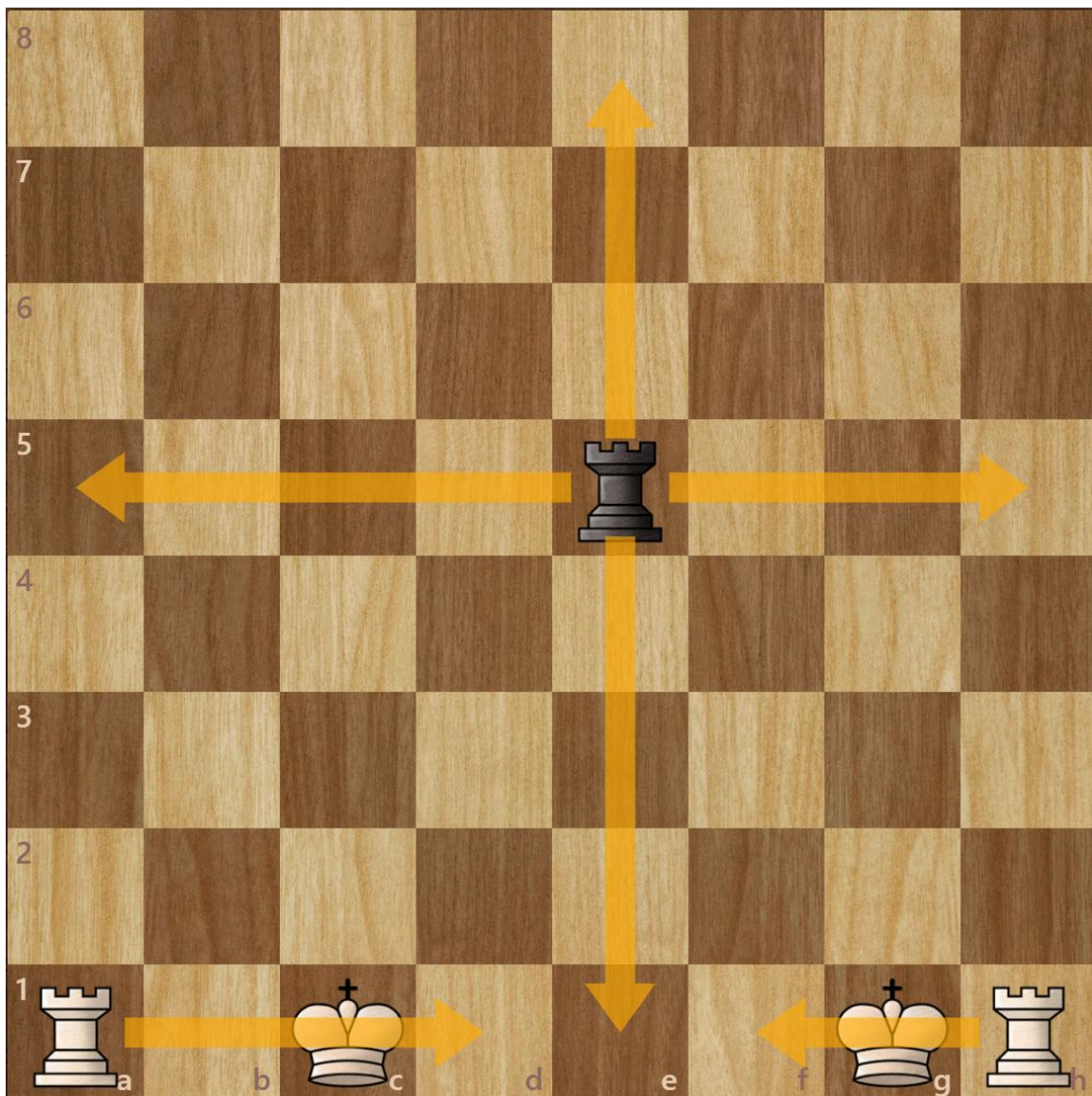

How Chess Pieces Move

### The Rook (R)

The Rook moves along ranks and files and as many squares as it likes. The Rook can jump over the King when the King castles.



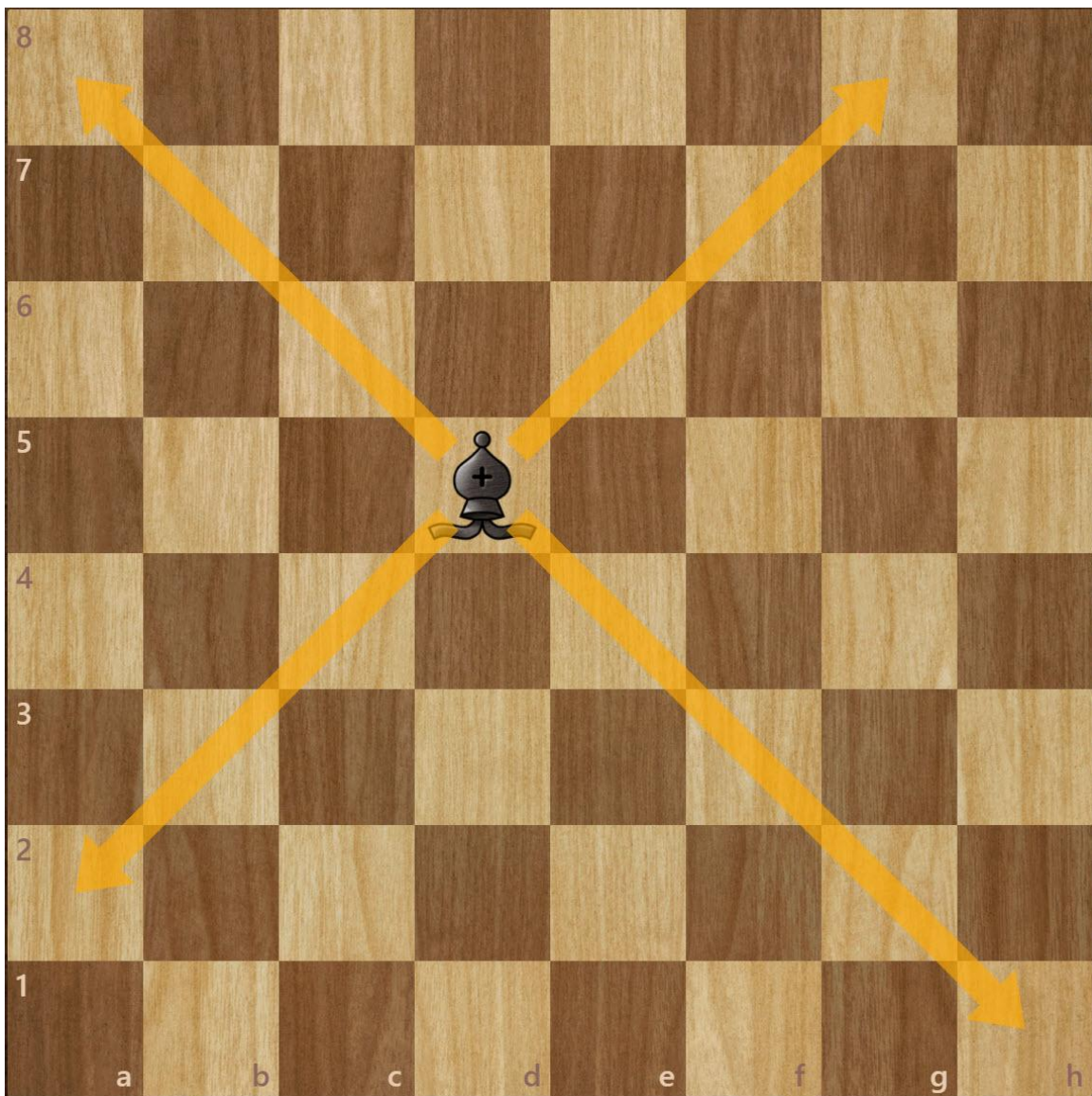

How Chess Pieces Move

### The Bishop (B)

The Bishop moves along the diagonals of the color of its starting square and as many squares as it likes.





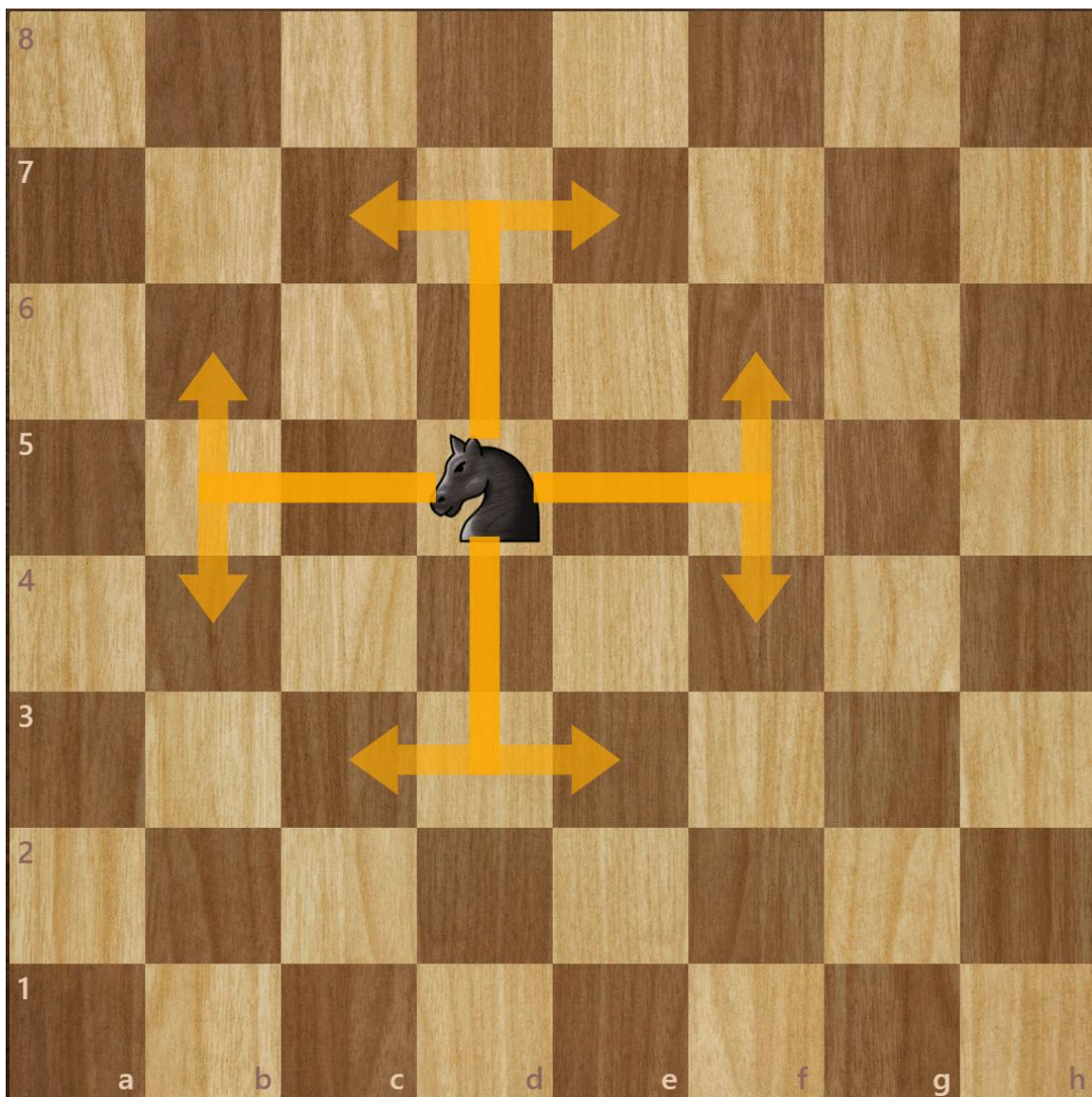

How Chess Pieces Move

### The Knight (N)

The Knight can jump over other pieces and moves in L-shaped hops.

How Chess Pieces Move

### The Pawn (P)

The Pawn moves one step forward at a time, but captures diagonally. On its first move, the Pawn can move either one or two spaces forward.
