



The Most Important Goals in Chess

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The Opening in Chess – Is a Race

Develop your chess pieces and don't waste time

- 1. Center Pawns
- 2. Knights
- 3. Bishops
- 4. Castle King Safety
- 5. Queen
- 6. Rooks

General Rules

- 1. Limit your Pawn moves
- 2. Move every piece only once
- 3. Aim for a development advantage
- 4. Don't attack before you "won" the race
- 5. Attack

The Middle Game in Chess - Improve Your Pieces

Look for CCTO = Checks, Captures, Threads, Optimize and SoH = Sit on Hands

- 1. Try to find better positions for your pieces, e.g., move rooks from the corners to open files or move the knights towards the middle of the board.
- 2. Don't move your good pieces before optimizing the bad pieces.

The End Game in Chess - Promote a Pawn

You reach the endgame when you have two pieces or fewer besides the king and pawns.

Of all the endgame theories, the aim is to promote a pawn

- 1. Create a passed pawn
- 2. Promote the passed pawn
- 3. Checkmate the opponent's king
