Musical and Bookings Policy:

- To book artistes who play "modern" or "mainstream" jazz; that is, jazz as developed from 1945 up to the present day;
- To book national and international artistes.

Objectives:

- To maintain the presence of live modern / mainstream jazz on a regular basis at a venue in Market Harborough;
- To provide a programme of jazz (within the terms of the M&B policy) to meet the needs of the Club Members;
- To ensure that jazz concerts are an informal and enjoyable community event.

Venue:

The venue for concerts by Harborough Jazz is in the Conference / Banqueting Suite of the Three Swans Hotel, High Street, Market Harborough. This is a separate building at the rear of the main Hotel and access is either by an open air walkway direct from the High Street, or from Fairfield Road at the rear of the Hotel site. The performance area allows a maximum audience of 112 people seated at tables, with 14 tables and 8 chairs per table. Seating is NOT bookable in advance; it is first come, first seated. There is an adjacent bar, and those attending are able to enjoy a drink during the performances. At lunchtime a limited range of hot and cold refreshments is available, provided by the hotel. However, these must be pre-ordered at the bar before the gig commences. The central town location of the hotel means that there is parking available (free on Sundays) in nearby council car parks. Note that parking at the back of the hotel is limited, and is also free.

Date and Time:

Concerts will generally be held on the SECOND Sunday of each month from September to June each Season, with a break in July and August. They will commence at 12.30pm, with the doors open for admission from 11.45am (ish). There will be a break for lunch from about 1.15pm until about 1.45pm. Concerts will end at about 2.30-3.00pm.

Admission Prices:

Currently admission prices vary from £10 / £12 to £18 / £20 (Member & Accompanied Guest / Non-Member). Advance bookings can now only be made by using the Ticket Source website.

Membership:
