February Meeting Round-up

On Saturday, February 15th Ring 96 met to hold or most recent meeting. We tried something a little different this month as our featured lecturer, Brady Glen, arrived early and led the pre-meeting workshop.

We started the meeting with a broken wand ceremony for Paul R. Miles. Paul was a long-time member of Ring 96 who had passed away on February 4th: Paul will be missed.

Brady started off by speaking on the importance of "pocket management." He went over how he loads his pockets and with what. He always knows where different colored decks are and where different types of decks are as well. The same was true for coins and other magical equipment. Now for a trick... Brady asked a volunteer to name a card. Six of Spades was called out. Brady picked up an envelope and the Six of Spades was the only card inside.

A volunteer shuffled a deck and pulled out a few cards. The Volunteer was told to look at the cards. Brady proceeded to correctly call out the cards in the volunteer had picked. This trick is a shocker for both magicians and lay audiences, and it relies on a very clever sleight.

Brady had a volunteer deal out some cards and stop when they felt like it. The card they stopped on was the ten of clubs. An envelope that had been sitting on the table the whole time, held a note that read you will stop on the ten of clubs. Brady spent some time talking about timing and how to get a volunteer to stop when you want without looking obvious about it.



Double cross was the next effect where the magician puts an "x" on his hand with a sharpie. It vanishes and appears on the volunteer's hand instead.

Brady credits Johnny Ace Palmer as his mentor who taught him all he knows about magic. He discussed with us how to approach a table when doing strolling magic, and how to know when to approach and when to back off.

Brady always carries lots of magical accessories and is always ready to perform a strolling show, a close-up show, a parlor show, or a stage show. You never know when you are hired for one show, and the audience is such that it calls for another. He is always ready to upgrade the show with the appropriate up charge as well. When Brady negotiates a show, he always tells the client all of his prices for all of his work. This lets the client decide what they want both up front and if changes need to be made. He also carries extra decks in case the need arises. He warned us, when working tables do not do the same tricks over and over. Rather have a large repertoire so that people at one table don't see the same effects they just watched over the next table's shoulders. Keep several different set lists at hand. Brady follows the rule of "Three." Everything he does comes in three phases and three parts. This makes it comfortable for the audience. Don't be afraid to do things in front of the table, as the spectators do not know what you are planning and working to.

A volunteer shuffles the deck and is asked what is his favorite card? The volunteer chose Nine of Diamonds. Brady said that his favorite card was the Queen of Clubs, which he pulled out of the deck. He had the volunteer insert the queen at random back into the deck. It proved to be right next to the volunteers Nine of Diamonds. This is an easy trick but does have one tough sleight involved in it.

Brady ended with Imaginations Coins. This trick involved four coins in a spectator's hand and the number of coins changes right under their nose.














February Sessioning
