

# Loose-fitting Gloves

This guidance allows loose-fitting gloves to be used without washing hands between each use as long as contamination of the hands or gloves (under the loose gloves) are protected from contamination

## Putting on Gloves

Gloves must be put on using a hands-free method. Examples include using a glove holder or dispenser that allows putting them on without touching the outside of the glove



## Using Gloves

Use gloves for handling the intended food only. Just like regular gloves, once dirty they should be removed before changing tasks



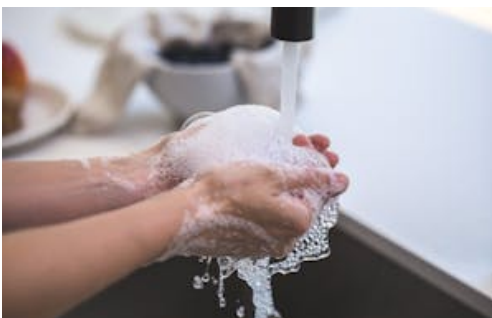
## Discarding Gloves

After use, the loose-fitting gloves must be removed using a method that does not contaminate the hands or gloves underneath, such as shaking the loose-fitting gloves off directly into the trash



## Washing Hands

As long as the gloves or gloved hands under the loose gloves remain clean, hand washing is not required after using the loose-fitting gloves
