



30-Day Family Salvation Prayer Guide

Daily Scripture & Focus

Day 1 (Sept 26) - Acts 16:31 - "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved, you and your household."

Focus: Declare salvation for your entire household.

Day 2 (Sept 27) - John 14:6 - "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me."

Focus: Pray they recognize Christ as the only way.

Day 3 (Sept 29) - 2 Corinthians 4:4 - Pray against spiritual blindness in your family.

Day 4 (Sept 30) - Romans 10:9-10 - Ask God to stir confession of Christ on their lips.

Day 5 (Oct 1) - Ezekiel 36:26 - Pray for a new heart and a new spirit in them.

Day 6 (Oct 2) - Luke 19:10 - Pray they encounter Jesus, the One who seeks the lost.

Day 7 (Oct 3) - John 6:44 - Ask the Father to draw them by His Spirit.

Day 8 (Oct 4) - Romans 3:23-24 - Pray they recognize their need for God's grace.

Day 9 (Oct 6) - Mark 11:23-24 - Speak faith that nothing is too hard for God.

Day 10 (Oct 7) - Proverbs 18:21 - Speak life and blessings over your family.

Day 11 (Oct 8) - Hebrews 9:12 - Declare Jesus' blood has made redemption available.

Day 12 (Oct 9) - Psalm 34:8 - Pray they will taste and see that the Lord is good.

Day 13 (Oct 10) - Isaiah 55:11 - Pray God's Word will not return void in their lives.

Day 14 (Oct 11) - 1 Timothy 2:4 - Pray they come to the knowledge of truth.

Day 15 (Oct 13) - Jeremiah 24:7 - Ask God to give them a heart to know Him.

Day 16 (Oct 14) - Romans 5:8 - Declare the love of Christ is revealed to them.

Day 17 (Oct 15) - Psalm 51:10 - Pray for a clean heart and renewed spirit.

Day 18 (Oct 16) - Romans 8:1 - Pray they embrace freedom in Christ, not condemnation.

Day 19 (Oct 17) - John 10:9 - Pray they enter through Christ, the Door.

Daily Scripture & Focus

Day 20 (Oct 18) - Titus 3:5 - Ask God to wash and renew them by His Spirit.

Day 21 (Oct 20) - 2 Corinthians 5:17 - Pray they become new creations in Christ.

Day 22 (Oct 21) - Ephesians 2:8-9 - Pray they receive salvation as a gift, not by works.

Day 23 (Oct 22) - Isaiah 61:1 - Declare freedom from every bondage in their lives.

Day 24 (Oct 23) - 1 John 1:9 - Pray they confess and receive forgiveness.

Day 25 (Oct 24) - Joel 2:32 - Call their names before God, declaring they will call on Him.

Day 26 (Oct 25) - Matthew 5:6 - Pray they develop a hunger and thirst for righteousness.

Day 27 (Oct 27) - Psalm 119:105 - Pray they walk in the light of God's Word.

Day 28 (Oct 28) - Galatians 5:1 - Declare freedom from generational bondage.

Day 29 (Oct 29) - Joshua 24:15 - Declare your family chooses to serve the Lord.

Day 30 (Nov 1) - Revelation 12:11 - Declare victory by the blood of the Lamb and the word of testimony.

Closing Declaration (Nov 1):

Father, thank You for hearing every prayer lifted over these 30 days. I believe by faith that my family will walk in salvation, freedom, and destiny in Christ. Let this be the beginning of transformation and testimony. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Daily Prayer Guide



Adoration

Father God, I thank You for being faithful and wonderful. You are King of kings and Lord of lords, Alpha and Omega, the Great I AM, the great Physician, miracle worker, promise keeper, and way maker. You created life and breathed breath into us. Thank You for sending Your only Son for the world You love. I honor Jesus, who is the way, the truth, and the life, and the only way to the Father (John 14:6). I honor Jesus, the Door, through whom anyone who enters is saved (John 10:9). I thank You that by His own blood He obtained eternal redemption once for all (Hebrews 9:12).

Confession and readiness

Lord, forgive me for anything that grieved You in thought, word, or deed, by omission or commission. Forgive me for any unkindness, unforgiveness, or misrepresentation of Your Kingdom. Cleanse me so nothing hinders my prayers. Guard my tongue because death and life are in its power (Proverbs 18:21). Give me grace to apologize where I have hurt others and to release those who have hurt me. Help me water my own grass. I confess that I have sometimes wanted other people's grass to look greener while neglecting to share the gospel within my own family. Begin with my house

Surrender of witness

Lord, make me a clear advertisement for Your Kingdom. Let the light of Christ shine through me into the places of darkness around me. Thank You that Jesus is the Door and the Way. Lead me as a laborer into Your harvest wherever You send me (Luke 10:2).

Intercession by name

Now Father, I bring my family to You. I lif	†,

In the authority of Jesus' Name, I bind the hands of the enemy who blinds their minds to the light of the gospel (2 Corinthians 4:4). I command the veil to lift and every blinding influence to loose them now. Jesus has already accomplished salvation. I pray for their acceptance of His finished work.

Gospel light and faith declarations

I declare that the light of the gospel is shining on them and the love of Jesus is entering their hearts.

I speak to every mountain of unbelief, deception, confusion, and hardness, be removed and cast into the sea, and do not return (Mark 11:23). I declare they will see, hear, and understand the gospel as never before, and that the Word will not return void but will accomplish what You please (Isaiah 55:11). I call them saved and filled with the Holy Ghost, in Jesus' Name.

Laborers and open doors

Lord of the harvest, send the right voices to cross their paths. Send people whom they will listen to, who will carry truth and love with clarity and boldness (Luke 10:2). Give them divine appointments, timely invitations, and undeniable encounters with Your presence.

Conviction, repentance, and healing

Holy Spirit, bring conviction of sin, righteousness, and judgment. Heal wounds that keep them bound. Break every ungodly tie and stronghold. Close doors to predatory influences that appear friendly but are destructive. Keep them from deception and draw them with cords of lovingkindness to the Son who is the Door and the only Way (John 10:9, John 14:6).

Covering for the intercessor and household

Strengthen me to pray without quitting. Guard my heart from offense and frustration. Let my words agree with Your Word. Give me courage and timing to share the gospel with my own family, and wisdom to know when to speak and when to be silent. Let my life preach Christ.

Agreement with God's will

Father, You desire all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth (1 Timothy 2:4). I agree with Your will for them to accept Jesus. By faith, I receive it. I believe I have what I ask because I ask according to Your Word and I do not doubt in my heart (Mark 11:23).

Thanksgiving and trust

Thank You for hearing me. Thank You that Jesus' blood has already secured redemption (Hebrews 9:12). I trust You to finish what You have begun.
