## Friday September 26, 2025 TOURNAMENT FORMAT 6 holes SCROUNGE

- Both players in partner team HIT their own tee shot
- On second shot SWITCH and hit Partner's ball
- Choose the best positioned ball between you and your partners second shot
- **SCRAMBLE** format the rest of the way to the hole
- A single TEAM score is recorded on the Score Card

## 6 holes SCRAMBLE

- Both players in partner team hit their own tee shot
- Every shot thereafter each player on the team hits their ball from the **BEST** partner team chosen ball position until the ball is in the hole.
- A single PARTNER TEAM score is recorded on the Score Card

## 6 holes SCATTER

- Both players in partner team tee off and then choose the best ball position between the partners
- From the chosen shot location each player SCATTERS...and hits their own ball the rest of the way until it is in the hole
- Each Partner Team records their *combined score* (added together) on the card

# Oxford Hill Stillies HARVEST JUG TOURNAMENT RULES

"Gimmee" allowance on each hole signified by white tape 12" up on each pin to improve pace of play Gimmee still counts as a shot and distance measured from edge of hole to the outside edge of white tape

Maximum Individual strokes on all holes is Double Par

Tip ups allowed but NO change in playing surface or removing from behind obstacles

On all Competition Formats players (with the exception of on the green) have one club length (no closer to the hole) to play their next shot. However the location of the ball must be on the same surface.

## **LOST BALL & OUT OF BOUNDS**

## **OPTION A**

Stroke & Distance Penalty

## **OPTION B**

- Hit a Provisional Ball if unsure of ball location or if it will be found
- If original ball is not OB or it is found then the provisional ball is disallowed
- If original ball is OB or lost the provisional ball will become official ball in play
- Stroke & Distance Penalty

## **OPTION C**

- Drop ball perpendicular on fairway where ball presumed lost or went out of bounds.
   up to 2 club lengths inside fairway edge
  - Not where it finished at rest but rather where it entered the OB area)
- Agreed location by opposing pair
- 2 Stroke Penalty

## RISK / REWARD

- (RISK) You hit your Ball in trouble again and more penalty strokes
- (REWARD) You hit a better shot safer and farther than Choice C

## RISK / REWARD

- (RISK) You hit the Provisional Ball in trouble again and more Penalty Strokes
- (REWARD) You hit a better shot safer and farther than Choice C

## RISK / REWARD

- (RISK) The loss of possible distance at the cost of the extra stroke penalty might not justify
- (REWARD) You are on the fairway with your prior troubles behind you

### LOST BALL

- (1) Balls lost in marked (example: red stakes) or declared\* hazards are penalized and played according to regular golf rules
- (2) If a player or teammate starts the 3 minute search and is unable to find their golf ball than only Option C is available to the player

### **OUT OF BOUNDS**

(3) Player must choose option A or B *prior* to leaving the location of their last stroke or they *must* use Option C. In other words... Once the player or teammate starts to search and investigate where the ball is they cannot turn around and go back to the original shot location. This is to keep play moving.
