

## 4 Days Orangutan Journey 2025

### Nature & Culture

#### Day 1 (L, D)

#### KUMAI - TANJUNG PUTING NATIONAL PARK

Upon your arrival in Pangkalan Bun, Central Kalimantan, you will be picked up by our tour guide part of the orangutan journey team and taken to Kumai (a harbor town) to board on your private boat so - called Klotok. This traditional wooden river boat is a boat about 15 m by 3 m with an upper deck for you to view the rainforest and the beautiful national park as it glides by. You will meet your journey team includes a boat captain (boat man), a captain assistant, and a chef.

About 2 hours from Kumai cruise up Sekonyer river to Tanjung Puting National Park, arrive at the first Camp **(Tanjung Harapan)** and trek the rainforest for about 1 km to watch the orangutans feeding at 3 PM. Take your time and enjoy the feeding activity, take

pictures, your guide will explain you the story of the camp and its resident orangutans after the feeding time.

Board to the boat, river safari and witness the wildlife around the river banks.

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Your first day ends by dinner on board, and overnight on board.

**Day 2 (B, L, D)**



**CAMP PONDOK TANGGUI - CAMP LEAKEY**

After breakfast onboard, cruise up Sekonyer river for about an hour to go to Camp 2 (Pondok Tanggui). The fresh morning air, the forest panorama and the colorful birds will always be part of your daily start.

On arrival at Camp Pondok Tanggui, a light trekking takes you to the feeding platform where you can enjoy the orangutans daily supplemental feeding starting by 9 in the morning. After the feeding activity, your tour guide will lead you on an exploration trek around Camp Pondok Tanggui forest area.

***“Board to the boat and continue for 1,5 hours upriver stream to the legendary Camp Leakey, the biggest research center for the orangutans established in 1971.”***

Your delicious lunch will be served on the boat along the way to get to Camp Leakey.

On arrival at Camp Leakey’s dock, you may (sometimes) be welcomed by some of the semi-wild Orangutans resident at Camp Leakey. Quite a large resident population of orangutans live around Camp Leakey as permanent residents.

Your guide will explain the history of the individuals you meet and you will find it

interesting to observe the social interaction of the orangutan families and individuals. Make sure that your camera is always ready to shoot every moment.

Trekking about 1,5 kms to the feeding platform to watch the orangutans feeding starts by 2 PM in Camp Leakey, along the way your tour guide will introduce you firsthand to the Borneo tropical

rainforest, one of the oldest tropical rainforests of the world. You have your chance to witness the orangutans in their real habitat, and the diverse flora and fauna over this area.



After the feeding activity, return to the boat by forest walk and stream down the river.

River safari to watch species of primates, wild animals, birds, and certainly see groups of the endemic Proboscis monkey.

This will amazingly end your

second day of the journey. Your evening is free time, dinner on board, rest, relax overnight in Rimba Lodge.

### Day 3 (B, L)

#### RIVER CRUISE – KUMAI – PANGKALAN BUN CITY TOUR

Breakfast at the Ecolodge.

You will be taken on board, do endemic tree planting program. Finished the tree planting program, back on board and heading back to Kumai harbor by a tranquil sailing, streaming down the river for about 2 hours. Your lunch will be served on board. Check in to Your Hotel in Pangkalan Bun, and free time for about 1 hour.

Your afternoon city tour starting by a visit to “Istana Kuning” The Historical Sultan Palace (Islamic Symbol in Pangkalan Bun), the only Islamic Kingdom in Central Borneo.

**“A traditional dance practice is the next thing to do on your afternoon, learning Dayak traditional dance from local dancers and experts, this culture visit must be so special at the icon house of Dayak’s traditional long house in Pasir Panjang village”.**

After the dance practice rehearsing, sunset time, you will get experience cruising Arut river in Pangkalan Bun by a traditional small machined canoe, so-called “Getek”. Sightseeing the local culture along the river and enjoying the sunset panorama.

Your evening time will be spent by dinner at a local restaurant.

Overnight at Grand Kecubung Hotel, Pangkalan Bun.

## Day 4 (B)

### AIRPORT TRANSFER

Breakfast at the Grand Kecubung Hotel in Pangkalan Bun, a perfect start to your morning. After breakfast, you have free time to relax and enjoy the hotel's amenities or explore the local area at your own pace.



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As your departure time approaches, our team will ensure a smooth transfer to the airport, arriving 1.5 hours before your flight. Your Orangutan Journey officially comes to an end.
