Driving and Towing Preparation

- Seriously consider taking an RV Driving/Towing class if you are new to RVing
- Practice driving or towing in a safe area before a long trip.
- Know your RV's height, weight, and turning radius.
- Perform a complete pre-trip inspection (tires, lights, slides, hookups).
- Use mirrors and blind spot cameras if available.
- Understand wide turns and braking distances.

RV Systems Familiarization

- Learn how to operate the water pump and monitor tank levels.
- Test and sanitize your fresh water system.
- Check the city water connection and use a pressure regulator.

- Understand water heater operation (propane/electric).
- Locate and test your water heater bypass and low point drains.

Electrical System Checks

- Know your shore power connection (15A, 30A, 50A).
- Use a surge protector or EMS system.

- Test all 120V and 12V systems (lights, outlets, appliances).
- Understand battery monitoring and converter/inverter usage.
- If equipped, test generator and solar charging.

Propane and Waste Systems

- Turn on propane and test all propane appliances.
- Test your propane detector and CO detector.
- Practice dumping black and gray tanks safely and hygienically.
- Use RV-specific toilet paper and tank treatments. (optional, research and make an informed decision for your RV) Toilet paper link https://amzn.to/4fzr848

 Add holding tank chemicals after dumping. (optional, research and make an informed decision for your RV)

Planning and Performing a Shakedown Trip

- Select a campground within 1-2 hours of home with full hookups.
- Test every system (water, power, propane, waste, HVAC).
- Practice leveling, backing in, and connecting/disconnecting utilities.
- Refine your packing list and identify missing items.
- Take notes on issues or noises for troubleshooting later.

Packing Essentials and Safety

- Bring sewer hose kit, leveling blocks, surge protector, and tool kit.
