□ Dump/Flush Holding Tanks (if needed):

□ Grey tank (dump).
□ Stow sewer hose and connections.
□ Unhook Shore Power: Disconnect electrical cable from pedestal and stow.
□ Unhook City Water: Disconnect water hose from pedestal and stow.
□ Unhook Cable/Satellite TV (if applicable): Disconnect and stow.
□ Stow Leveling Jacks: Retract all leveling jacks completely.
□ Retract Awnings: Ensure all awnings are fully retracted and secured.
□ Close/Secure All Compartment Doors: Double-check all exterior storage bays are latched.
□ Close/Secure All Windows & Roof Vents: Ensure they are fully closed and locked.
□ Antenna/Satellite Dish Down: Retract any TV or satellite dishes.
□ Check Tires:
□ Visual inspection for damage/low pressure.
□ Check tire pressure with gauge
□ Check Lug Nuts: Ensure they are tight (especially after maintenance).
□ Disconnect Chocks/Blocks: Remove wheel chocks and leveling blocks.
□ Secure Entry Steps: Ensure steps are fully retracted and latched.
