Founded in 2022, TE4CL – Kia Eke is a care-experienced-led initiative dedicated to ensuring that care leavers have equitable access to higher education in Aotearoa. We work alongside key partners—including universities, Oranga Tamariki, the Tertiary Education Commission, and VOYCE Whakarongo Mai—to drive meaningful change. As a values-driven organisation, we are committed to **Te Tiriti o Waitangi** and prioritising **Te ao Māori** in all our mahi.

About the Role

As our **Media Communications Specialist**, you'll lead and develop TE4CL – Kia Eke's communications strategy, under the guidance of the Executive Director, ensuring our message reaches the right people in the right ways. You'll manage our website, social media, newsletters, and reports while working closely with the Executive Director to drive awareness, engagement, and advocacy.

- Part-time contract (10 hours per week, 48 weeks per year, with potential for extension by 24 months depending on TE4CL's organizational need).
- **\$32 per hour** (contractor role—applicants must handle their own tax obligations including GST if applicable)
- **Remote working** (flexible hours, with potential co-working space access). As a contractor, the successful applicant will use their own computer equipment /laptop.

- Develop and implement our media and communications strategy, alongside the Executive Director.
- Manage and maintain TE4CL Kia Eke's website, social media platforms (Instagram, LinkedIn, and other platforms deemed as suitable), newsletters, and reports.



- Enhance our reach by evaluating social media engagement, trends, and audience feedback.
- **Support advocacy efforts** through strategic communications and content creation.
- Collaborate with stakeholders to share relevant content and strengthen partnerships.{
