Thanks to everyone who's reached out over the past few weeks with feedback. It's clear there's a lot of excitement heading into the upcoming season and a shared interest in continuing to make the club the best it can be.

One topic worth keeping on our radar (no action needed right now) is the timing of Classic lake selection.
