






























TIPS FOR PARENTS

• Explain age limits and inappropriate content. Many online sites or games have a minimum age restriction. Explain to your child that age limits exist to protect them from content that might not be suitable.

Set Ground Rules

Talk to your child and find out what things they like to do online. Agree on websites, apps and games that are best for them to use.

· Be calm and reassuring

Let your child know that they can talk to you or a trusted adult if they come across unsuitable content.

· Encourage Critical Thinking

Help your child to think about what activities they should or should not do when they are online.
