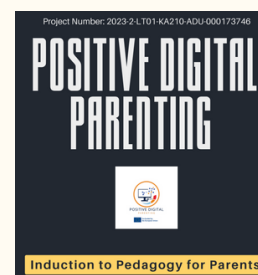
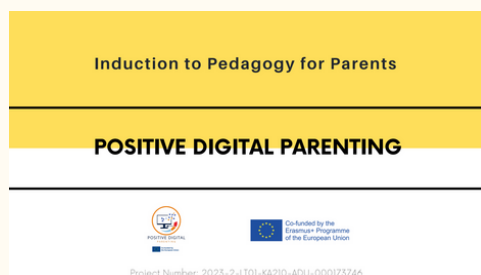
Comic Strips for Children (Aged 8-12)
