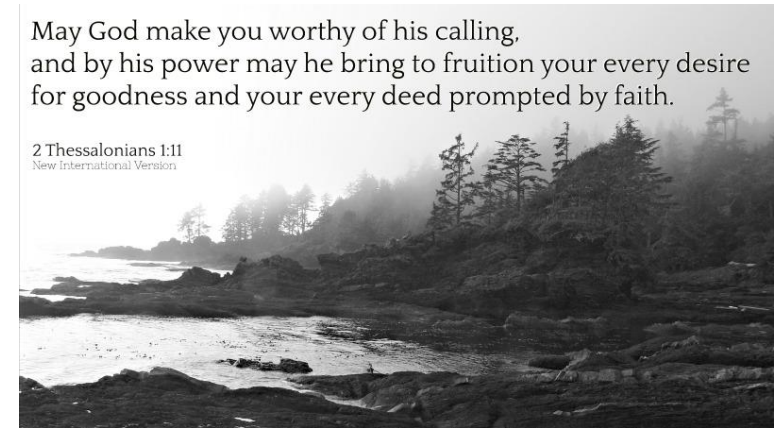
The grand total of pledges received will be divided to determine how much will be donated per puzzle. They anticipate about four or five puzzles total.
