

Photographs and Identity Card:

- 1. Six numbers, passport size, and three numbers stamp size colored, photographs are required with the application.
- 2. Each trainee will the issued an identity card. Which must be carried to the Institute every day.

Attendance:

As per NCVT norms, minimum attendance required is 80% of the training period. Non-compliance will disallow trainees from appearing in the annual examination.

Holidays:

As per ITI/ITC norms there are no vacations. The Center will work throughout the year. Holidays will be as permissible by the Department of Employment and Training, Government of Karnataka.

CRAFTSMEN TRAINING

The Directorate General of Employment & Training (DGE&T) in the Ministry of Labour, Government of India initiated Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS) in 1950 by establishing Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) for imparting skills in various vocational trades to meet the skilled manpower requirements for technology and industrial growth of the country.

The object of the scheme are:

- i) to ensure steady flow of skilled workers in different trade for the Industry.
- ii) To raise the quality and quantity of industrial production by systematic training of workers; and
- iii) To reduce unemployment among the educated youth by equipping them for suitable industrial employment.

UNIFORM

Student shall get two sets of uniform stitched within 7 days from the date of admission and shall wear the same daily right from his residence till reaching back to the residence.

Facilities:

Progress Card:

Progress card, for every trainee will be maintained from the date of admission to the institute. monthly test will be conducted in the subjects and performance will be recorded on monthly and quarterly basis for awarding the sessional mark. Following criteria will also form part of regular assessments:

- i. Responsibility towards the Tools, Equipment and allotted work.
- ii. industry, diligence, accuracy and speed.
- iii. Regularity in attendance and punctuality.
- iv. Cleanliness (Personal, Workplace, Tools and Equipment)
- v. Inter-personal behavior including Curiosity, Obedience, Enthusiasm nd Sincerity to learn.

Certificates:

- 1. Provisional Certificate will be issued at end of successful completion of the Courses.
- 2. National Trade Certificate will be made available as soon as it is received from NCVT, New Delhi.

Sports and Extra Curricular Activities

To maintain a healthy body and holistic development, extracurricular activities and sports will be compulsory.

Hostel:

The Center, run a hostel with arrange for accommodation of trainees.

Rules:

LIBRARY RULES

The Institute is furnished with a rich and information library comprising of renowned books and nation wide Accepted journals to enhance technical education.

During Institute hours, library is opened to all the students perusing their ITI study from the institution. A library is satisfying the thirst for knowledge To enable this task certain rules are required to be followed for conduct of discipline for benefit to all These rules will help in creating necessary condition under which the library in the modern sense can be established and maintained adequately to serve the needs of users.

The rules are appended below:

Student must bring library card complete with photo identifications duly signed by librarian and Principal with them. The books will be issued only when the library card is produced before the librarian.

Books can be issued only on personal card.

Student must maintained pin drop silence in the library.

Books will be issued only for 15 days. After 15 days students charged @ 5/- per day as a late fine.

While lie book issued to the borrowers is damaged or destroyed he/she will have to pay the fine.

Students are strictly prohibited to bring their personal book and their belonging in the Library.

If a student wants to keep the books for more than 15 days, the book will be re-issueed to him/heron the decision of librarian.

General Rules

- 1. All trainees will undergo medical examination by the Doctors selected by Institute, from time to time .
- 2. All trainees should aim to conduct themselves according to the highest standards of manners and discipline.
- 3. Punctual and regular attendance is esssential for good progress in studies and conducive to molding of character.
- 4. Dignity for labor is an important aspect of training. No job is considered below one's dignity. therefore, all training must be ready to work hard including any type of physical work. This includes cleaning and maintenance of institute premises, gardens, classrooms, workshops, lunchroom, toilets, tools, and materials by the students.
- 5. No trainee shall leave the classroom or workshop without permission from his/her instructor.
- 6. Each trainee must ensure to wear complete neat and clean uniform throughout the course.
- 7. Trainees are allowed to carry out practical as assigned by his/her instructor.
- 8. Safety regulations must be followed institute will not be responsible for any injury or disablement caused due to non-observance of the prescribed regulations.
- 9. Each trainee or his/her parents or guardian must meet expenses of damage (s) of institute property, due to negligence, willfulness or disobedience of orders or rules. Depending upon the seriousness of the case, this will lead to immediate expulsion from the Center.
- 10. Any form of leave shall be addressed in advance to the Principal pr his representative stating the period and reason for leave applied for. Absence without permission will be treated as misconduct and fine will be charged. For leave, taken in excess of permissible leave, a fine will be imposed. Any repetition will lead to serious disciplinary action against the trainee.
- 11. In case of illness, a medical certificate from a recognized practitioner is essential.
- 12. 80% attendance is the minimum for a trainee to be eligible to appear for to All India Trade Test. Non-compliance will disqualify the trainee from appearing in the NCVT examination.
- 13. The Center ill take serious note of willful acts of misbehavior, such as use of obscene words or actions, disobedience, fights in or out of institute premises and irregular attendance, which will lead to sever punishment and possible dismissed.
- 14. The case, any trainee shows unsatisfactory performance or conduct, at the first instance, action will be a verbal reprimant. In this, a warning in writing in will be given to him with a copy to his/her parents/guardian. Recurrence of the same or similar offence, will lead to suspension or dismissal from the Center. In such an eventuality, the student will not have any claim for a refund of any fees or amounts paid (Other than Deposit).
- 15. Unless permitted by the Principal, no trainee shall become a member of any club, association, union or the like,

which is not conducive to the academic credibility of the trainee.

- 16. No trainee shall play in any team against the team of the institute.
- 17. Smoking, alcohol and drugs are strictly prohibited within the premises of the institute.
- 18. trainees are not allowed to bring jewelry, motorbikes, mobile phones, transistors, radios, cameras and other such expensive and electronic gadgets to institute premises.
- 19. time and again, the above-mentioned rule are liable to change. Each trainee will be bound by these rules in force at the time.
- 20. Each trainee and his/her parents shall give an Undertaking on a Stamp Paper to abide by these institute rules.



Fitter:

- a. Size metal part to required dimensions and assemble various types of machines and mechanical equipments.
- b. Cut and shape required part to dimensions and assemble by process of sawing, chipping, filing, grinding, drilling, screw cutting, scraping etc.
- c. Use precision measuring instruments. Do overhauling of machines.
- d. Forging, welding, turning, pipe fitting and sheet metal work.
- e. Extra need based training on machines.

Eligibility:

- 1. S.S.L.C. pass or 10th standard pass under 10+2 system with good scores in Science and Mathematics.

Leave Admissible To Trainees:

- 1. Casual leave: 12 days per year, subject to a maximum of 6 days at a time, excluding the intervening holidays.
- 2. Medical leave:
- a. 15 days shall be allowed owing to illness, on a medical certificate from a registered medical practitioner.
- b. In case of serious illness, a further period, not exceeding 6 weeks, for the entire period of 2 year is also admissible which, a certificate from the nearest Government Hospital should support.
- 3. Special leave: On prior permission 10 days Special leave for private affairs such as birth marriage and such other social function is allowed.
- 4. Students who remain absent for more than 15 days at a stretch without information will automatically be struck off from the rolls.

Careers:

Scope of training:

The focus will be on interactive learning to gain knowledge so as to ensure a stable foundation through practical exercises. In order to help student beome good citizens, discipline and personality development will be inbuilt into time spent at the center. trainees will have 'Hands-on' exercises in Industries, where they will learn to execute various operations accurtely, efficiently and safely.

Points to follow:
