ORDINANCE NO. 413

**AN ORDINANCE REGARDING THE PROVISION OF SEPARATE UTILITY SERVICES BY THE CITY OF HAVILAND, KANSAS**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HAVILAND, KANSAS:**

**SECTION 1. PURPOSE.** The purpose of this ordinance is to ensure the proper utilization of the utility services provided by the City in order to prevent the unpermitted disposal of wastewater and refuse.

**SECTION 2. REQUIREMENTS FOR CITY WATER SERVICE.**

- a. No premises that is equipped with access to the City sewer system will be permitted to have current City Water Service without also having current City Sewer Service.
- b. All premises with current City Water Service and current City Sewer Service shall also be required to have current City Trash Service.

**SECTION 3. EXCEPTIONS TO REQUIREMENTS.**

- a. Any premises that do not have existing access to the City Sewer System shall be eligible for current City Water Service without the requirement of current City Sewer Service until such time as access to the City Sewer System from such premises is established.
- b. Such premises described above that do not have access to the existing City Sewer System may be permitted, but are not required, to have City Trash Service.

**SECTION 4. DEFINITIONS.** The following definitions shall apply in the interpretation and enforcement of this ordinance:


- a. "City Water Service" means the provision of water to consumers by the City of Haviland, Kansas, via distribution through the City of Haviland, Kansas, Public Water System.
- b. "City Sewer Service" means the provision of wastewater disposal by means of the City Sewer and Wastewater System.
- c. "City Trash Service" means weekly refuse disposal services provided through the City of Haviland, Kansas, to residential and commercial premises.
- d. "Access to the City Sewer System" is defined as having any existing connection from the premises to City Sewer System, including but not limited to sinks, toilets, bath tubs, showers, or RV hook ups connected to the City Sewer System.


**SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication once in the official City newspaper.

**SECTION 6. SAVINGS CLAUSE.** If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining portions of this ordinance shall remain valid and forcible existence.

**SECTION 7. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances enacted prior to this ordinance in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
