
Their team is consistent in showing up weekly to show the love of Christ in action and deed. If you would like to hear more about them you will find them on Facebook.

ANNOUNCING A NEW PARTNERSHIP!!!

We have partnered with a shelter called Faith House. This shelter is for women and children coming out of extreme circumstances. The shelter has housing and food provided through state funding but does not have the funds for any extras such as clothing, school supplies, bedding, diapers and many other items. They need support from the community. It was no accident that I met a wonderful woman named Gail who lives on my street! She came over for coffee, and I learned about this program. She is an active volunteer at Faith House. This shelter has over 20 rooms and is quite large. In the last few months we have helped with: School supplies for the children at the shelter, multiple sets of new sheets for twin beds, several cases of baby wipes and diapers, many clothing donations including some new clothes and shoes for a few teenagers and household items!

I recently took a tour to see the facility. I found the housing very impressive, and I intend to get more involved soon.

Currently, they have over 50 people attending their home gatherings on a Saturday night! This is pretty impressive since they only began a few months ago! Families are showing up to hear the gospel as they open up their home to the community for the Lord to work! Initially, they needed a couch and furniture to get started with the vision the Lord had given them. We provided for that need (with 2 sectional couches, a dining room table, Bibles and supplies) and they quickly got busy after the furniture arrived to invite the community into their home. The Lord has been moving mightily! In only a few months, their numbers have grown to over 50 people attending their gatherings! They provide food, worship and the gospel regularly to their community! It is exciting to see how the Lord is quickly expanding their ministry as they obey. You can follow them on Instagram.
