






# About Us

We are the Iraqi Istklal Assembly, a national opposition movement that emerged from within Iraq to unify the efforts of Iraqis striving for genuine change.

Our assembly was founded in response to the continued failure of the political system over the past two decades. Our goal is to restore national sovereignty and build a strong, independent, and just state. We firmly believe that decision-making in Iraq must rest solely in the hands of Iraqis, and that national interest must take precedence over all sectarian, partisan, ethnic, or factional considerations.

# **Our Rationale**

•The political process has failed to meet the aspirations of the Iraqi people since 2003, particularly in matters of sovereignty, security, and justice.

•Corruption has become deeply entrenched within state institutions, leading to the collapse of public services and the erosion of citizens' trust in the state.

has undermined national decision-making and turned Iraq into an arena for settling regional and international conflicts.



• Socioeconomic crises

have worsened, exacerbated by the persistent absence of justice and equality.



• The rule of law

is absent, while uncontrolled weapons outside state authority continue to weaken the state's legitimacy and institutions.

Building a strong and independent state of institutions based on the principles of citizenship and justice.

Ending foreign influence and interventions in both the internal and external affairs of Iraq.


Achieving the rule of law and ensuring that arms are solely in the hands of the state.




Combating political, administrative, and financial corruption in all its forms.


We aspire to assume leadership in Iraq through legitimate democratic mechanisms, grounded in our commitment to the peaceful transfer of power and respect for the will of the people.

We believe Iraq must be a stabilizing force in the region and an honest partner in supporting global peace and security — without compromising its national sovereignty.








### **Conditions for Our Participation in the Electoral**

We will not participate in any electoral process unless the following conditions are met:



#### **Condition One**

• Elections must be free and fair, ensuring equal opportunities for all national forces.



#### **Condition** Two

• The electoral process must be free from the influence of arms, and no party or entity with an armed wing should be allowed to influence voters.

#### **Condition** Three

- All forms of foreign intervention and political funding must be strictly prohibited.
- Elections must be genuinely democratic, not merely symbolic, and overseen by an independent and impartial judiciary to guarantee the integrity of results.
- A safe and neutral environment must be ensured that allows the true and free expression of the popular will.
