Wayforth Solutions LLC ("Wayforth Solutions," "we," "our," or "us") uses cookies and similar tracking technologies to operate **wayforthsolutions.com** and any associated web or mobile applications (collectively, the "Site"). This Cookie Notice explains what cookies are, which ones we use, why we use them, and how you can control your preferences.

**Plain-English takeaway:** Cookies help the site remember you, keep you logged in, and tell us which pages are working. You can turn most of them off whenever you like.

### 1. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files stored on your device (computer, phone, tablet) when you visit a website. They allow the site to recognize your device and store information about your visit—such as your preferred language or items in a shopping cart. "Session cookies" disappear when you close your browser; "persistent cookies" stay until they expire or you delete them.

We also use similar technologies (e.g., local storage, pixels, and scripts). For simplicity, this Notice refers to all of these as "cookies."

# 2. Why We Use Cookies

We do **not** use cookies to sell your personal data.

## 3. Cookie Lifespan

- Session cookies: expire when you close your browser.
- **Persistent cookies**: remain on your device for 1 day to 24 months, depending on purpose (see table above).

### 4. Your Cookie Choices

When you first visit the Site, a banner will ask you to accept or manage cookies. You can:

- 1. Accept All let us set all cookies listed above.
- 2. Customize allow only certain categories (e.g., disable Marketing).
- 3. Reject Non-Essential keep only Strictly Necessary cookies.

You can change your preference anytime by clicking "Cookie Settings" at the bottom of the page.

#### **Browser Controls**

Most browsers let you delete or block cookies altogether. See the help pages for Chrome, Firefox, Safari, or Edge. Blocking Strictly Necessary cookies may break parts of the Site.

#### **Do Not Track**

Our Site does not currently respond to "Do Not Track" signals because there is no industry standard for compliance.

## 5. Third-Party Cookies

Some cookies come from third parties that provide services on our behalf. For example, Google Analytics collects usage stats; Stripe sets cookies to process payments securely. These third parties may combine the data with other information they hold. Their use of cookies is governed by their own privacy policies.
