

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Monitoring Requirements Not Met for City of Oak Park

On June 20, 2026, we became aware that our system recently failed to collect the correct number of drinking water samples. Although this incident was not an emergency, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did (are doing) to correct this situation.

**We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether our drinking water meets health standards. During 01/01/2026-03/31/2026] J&T Environmental did not test for Regulated Radionuclides and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time. **

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do currently. You may continue to drink the water. If a situation arises where the water is no longer safe to drink, you will be notified within 24 hours.

What is being done?

We are monitoring quarterly for Radionuclides this quarter will be monitored and will continue to monitor on this schedule [until/unless] we qualify for reduced monitoring.
